THE NEW LIQUOR LAW.

The main provisions of the new liquor bill just passed by the legislature of this state are as follows:

1. Spiritous, malt or vinous liquors cannot be sold in less quantities than one quart.

2. Every person obtaining a license shall pay into the county treasury the sum of \$400 per annum.

3. Every person applying for a license shall execute a bond in the sum of \$100, conditioned that he will keep an orderly house, no gaming or riotous conduct allowed, and that he will not open a saloon...

4. That any person desiring a license, before obtaining it, shall obtain the signatures of an actual majority of the whole number of legal voters in the precinct, and no applicant shall be deemed to have a majority of all the votes cast at the last preceding election...

5. That said applicant shall cause the said petition to be published in a newspaper for four consecutive weeks.

6. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as to apply in any manner to incorporated towns and cities of this state.

7. The Act to take effect upon its approval by the Governor.
