The Indian appropriation bill for the fiscal year 1890 is completed by the House committee. It carried an appropriation by nearly \$5,000,000, which is somewhat below the appropriation for the current fiscal year.

Recent investigations showed that more than one third of a congressman's time was spent in securing offices for his constituents. The interests of the people consequently suffer. Out of the 17,000 measures introduced in the last congress, more than 11,000 were never reported from the committee, about 1400 were reported but never acted upon, and less than 1000 were finally reported of in the house or senate.

Farmers claim that they are discriminated against in favor of cattlemen by Indian Territory officials.

The territory west of the Rocky Mountains is comparatively free from tornadoes. In the Mississippi valley they are most frequent, though they make themselves felt in all parts of the United States. In a single tornado season over 1,000 lives may be lost and property valued at over \$10,000,000 destroyed.

In 1884, the destruction in one day (September 26) being estimated at \$1,000,000. In 1882 (June 17th) nearly half the town of Linn, Iowa, was laid waste. About 100 people were killed and 150 injured and 160 houses were destroyed; the money loss was about \$3,000,000. At Rochester, Minn., on August 21, 1884, 26 people were killed and 52 injured. A railroad train was lifted into the air and shattered by the wind. At Andersons, Ala., on Feb. 19, 1884, 14 persons were killed by a tornado, and at Rockingham, N. C., on the same day, 15 or 20 persons were killed, some being carried over 600 feet in the air. Several other places suffered, the total loss for the day being 800 killed, while 2,500 were wounded and 1,500 left homeless.
