SUMMONS.

IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON, FOR GRANT COUNTY. Alexander Phlayson, Plaintiff, vs. I. Colette, Adeline Summons, Colette, W. L. Campbell and Fleckenstein & Mayer, Defendants.

To I. Colette, Adeline Colette, Fleckenstein & Mayer, four of the above named defendants: In the name of the State of Oregon, you are hereby required to appear and answer the complaint filed against you in the above entitled suit on or before Monday, the 9th day of November, A. D. 1891, the same being the first day of next regular term of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, for Grant county; and if you fail to do so, I will thereupon apply to the court for the relief prayed for in the complaint, to-wit: That Plaintiff have judgment against the Defendants, I.
