A FEW drops in a capful of warm water, applied carefully, will remove CONCERNING OTHER NATIONS. spots from paintings and chromos.

GHEASE spots may be taken out with weak ammonia in water: lay soft white paper over and iron with a hot iron.

VELLOW stains left by sewing machine oil on white may be removed by rubling the spot with a cloth wet with aminomia before washing with soap.

Equat parts of ammonia and turpentine will take paint out of clothing. even if it be hard and dry. Saturate the spot as often as necessary and wash out in soup ands.

Ir those who perspire freely would use a little ammonia in the water they bathe in every day it would keep the flish clean and sweet, doing away with any disagreeable odor.

PUT a tablespoonful of ammonia in a quart of water, wash your brushes and mby in this, and all grease and dirt will disappear. Rinse, shake and dry in the ann or by the fire.

FLANNEL and blankets may be soaked in a pail of water containing one tablespoonful of ammonia and a little ands But as little as possible, and they will be white and clean and will not shrink.

WATERS BIG AND LITTLE.
