

TEN LITTLE KIDS.

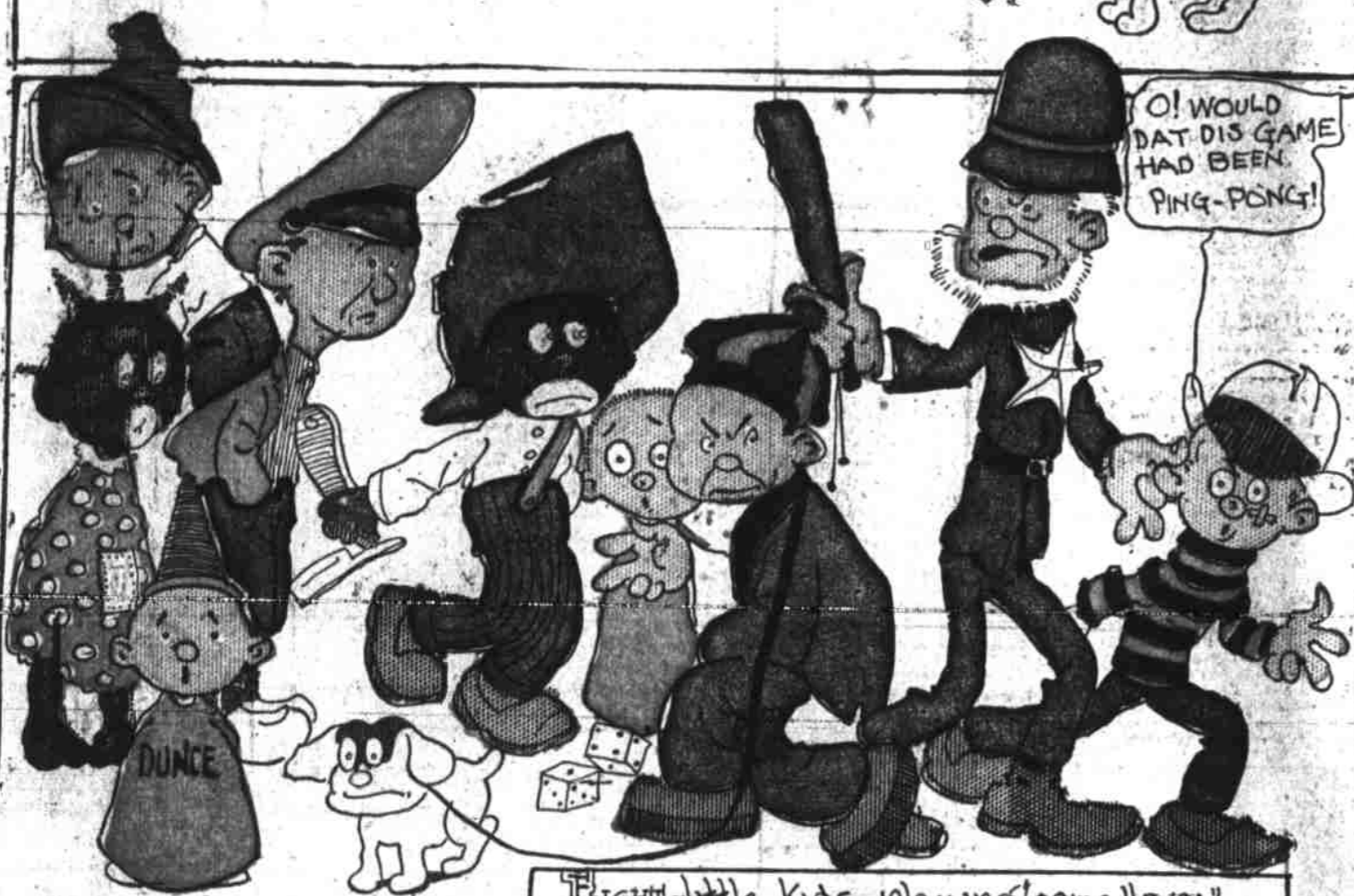

And then there were eight.



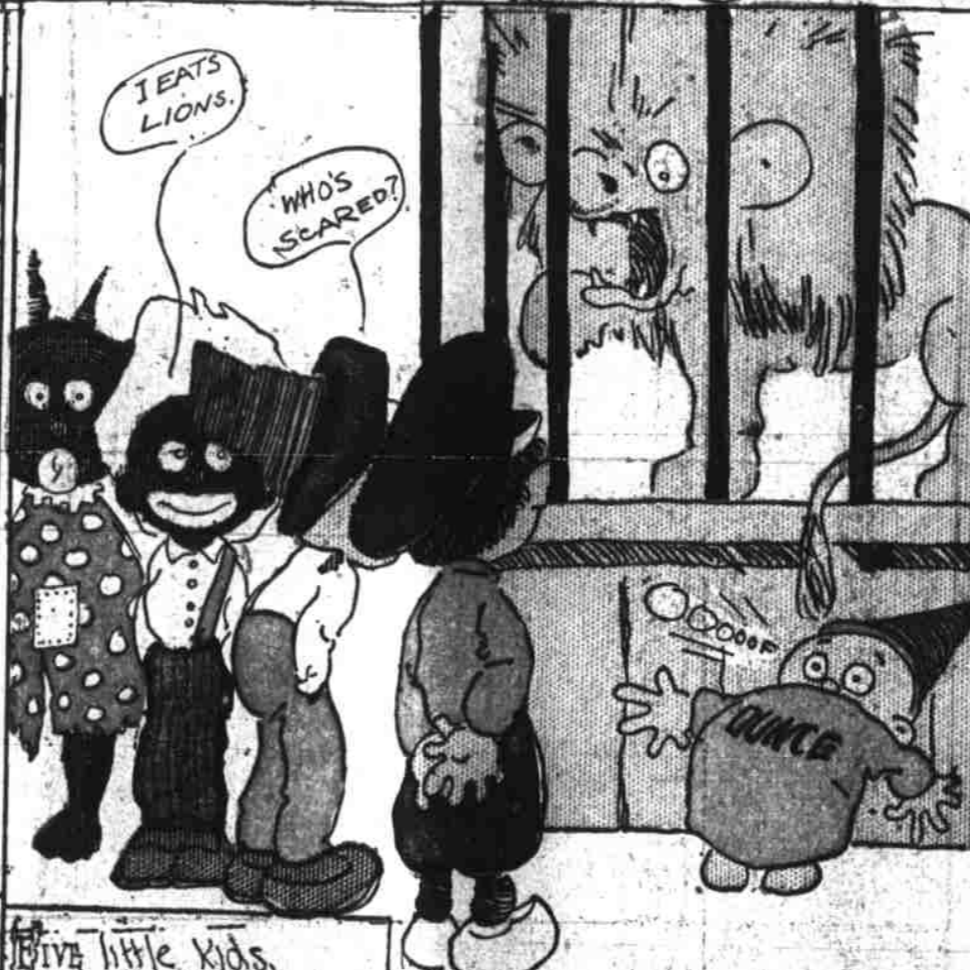
Eight little kids, playing 'come seven',
One got pinched, and then there were seven.



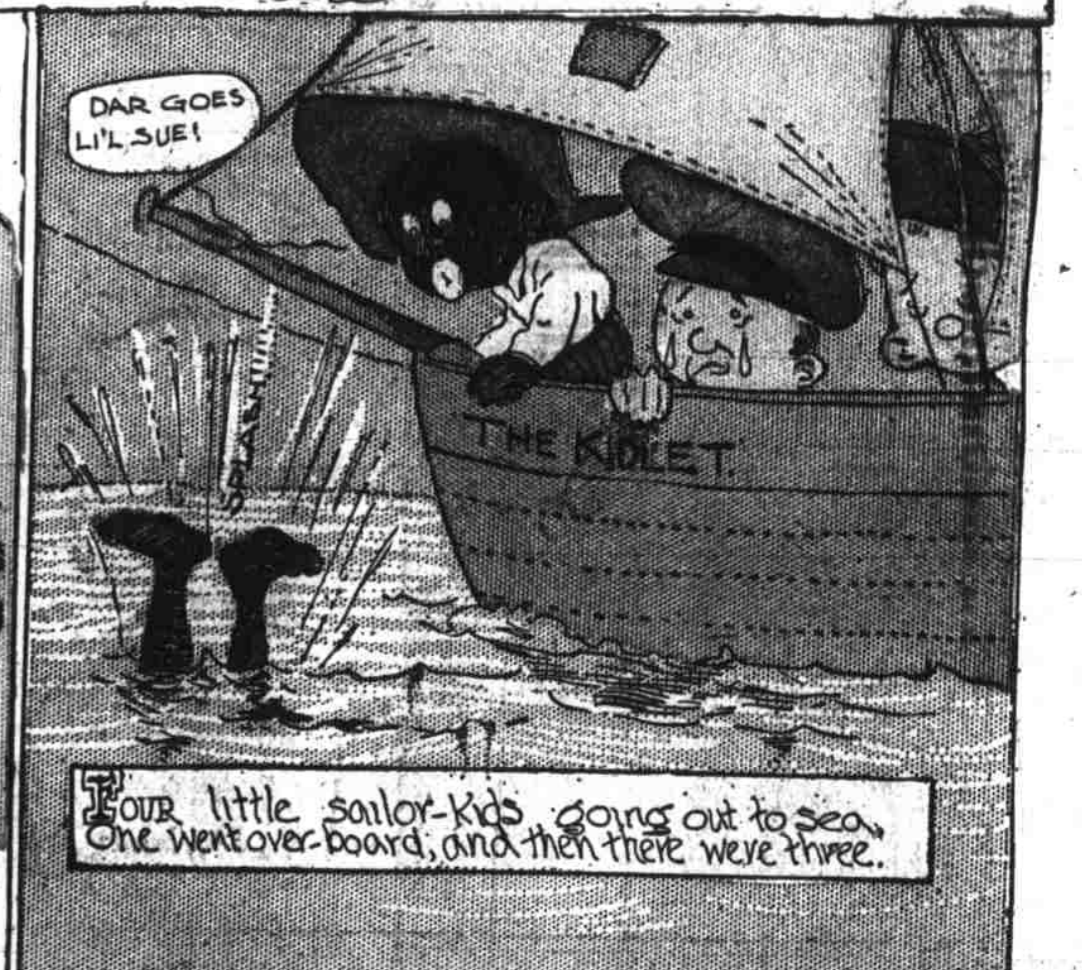
Seven little funny kids,
