HOPS ARE BEING SOLD IN VALLEY

Portland Dealers Make Purchases of 345 Bales at Quotations Ranging from 20 to 21 Cents a Pound.

Rains do Some Good to Crops—First Shipments of California Canteloupes and Peaches Arrive.

HOPS ARE BEING SOLD IN VALLEY

Several sales of hops have been made from the valley at prices ranging from 20 to 21 cents a pound. Dealers are securing everywhere to make purchases at these quotations.

From up the valley comes the report that several hop sales were made on Thursday at prices ranging from 20 to 21 cents a pound. Phil Neils of this city is reported as having bought bales of choice stock from Stern Bros. of Oakland, at 21 cents a pound and another local dealer whose name could not be ascertained made a purchase of 270 bales of choice stock at 20 cents a pound from Stern Bros. at Eugene. The market is excited over these transactions and as all local dealers have plenty of orders for stock ranging from 20 to 21 cents a pound, a lively scramble to make purchases before the stocks are depleted is on foot.

Rains do Some Good.

The past few days of rainy weather has wonderfully helped the hop yards up the valley and although there are large numbers of hills totally bare of vegetation, the vines that are up are doing well and the shortage will not amount to as much as some time ago predicted. It is now thought that the State of Oregon's yield for the coming season will amount to about 80,000 bales.

Poultry Prices Decline.

Too much poultry and a smaller demand caused a decline in poultry prices this morning and commission men are making endeavors to clean up at any old price. The market is glutted with a fresh supply. Still lower prices are looked for.

The Egg Situation.

Turner & Co. say of the egg situation: "Eggs are moving freely at quotations ranging from 15 to 18 cents a dozen and although the receipts are fairly liberal, there is no trouble to dispose of all holdings at the ruling prices. The market is steady and has every tendency to remain so for some time. Receipts of stock this season have been somewhat more liberal than that of a year ago, but the heavier demand has helped to boost prices."

Season Opens in earnest.

Levy & Spiegel received this morning the first consignment in this city of California peaches and canteloupes, first class and is quoted at \$1.75 per box. The Pierson-Pace Company received the street's initial shipment of canteloupes from the South this morning and the stock is being quoted at \$5 per half crate and \$10 per whole box. The canteloupes are from Coachella, Cal. The same firm received the first shipment today of a new variety of berries. They are called the Logan berry and are a cross between a black and a raspberry. The stock is quoted at \$2 per 16-box crate.

Oregon Cherries Arrive.

Oregon cherries of fairly good quality arrived on the street today and are being sold at \$1.75 per 16-box crate. A car of mixed vegetables, composed mostly of cabbage, was received from Sacramento this morning.

Lemons Still Scarce.

Lemons are a luxury on the street today, the supply being very short and quotations are in evidence. Dealers can make the purchase pay. Two cars of lemons are due to arrive from the South during the coming week, the first car being expected on Monday morning. Three cars of oranges are also due during the coming week.

Oregon Raspberries Arrive.

Some small consignments of Oregon raspberries arrived today and are finding a good sale at prices ranging from 25 to 35 cents a pound.

Red Onions Not So Plentiful.

The season for California new red onions is about over and the crop is becoming smaller. Some small shipments of new California Silverskins are due to arrive the latter part of next week. Quotations will be higher than the opening figure of last season.

Wheat and Shorts Weaker.

Feed prices were weaker today on account of the lateness of the season and the too-high prevailing quotations. Bran and shorts prices are especially high for general use and although the local markets do not show much weakness on account of the shortage of stocks from the outside, still there is a slackening off of city orders.

Bull Durham to Advance.

The American Tobacco Company has notified local jobbers of an advance of 3 cents a pound on Bull Durham smoking tobacco to take effect on July 1. The tobacco market is quoted strong and there is now an indication of advances all along the line in smoking.

Plenty of Puget Sound Salmon.

There is plenty of Puget Sound salmon in the local markets to supply all demand at prevailing quotations. Local stock is not arriving at all and a genuine Chinook would now be a sort of curiosity in this market. Demand for all kinds of fish is small on account of the warmness of the weather. Quotations are unchanged.

Strength in Wheat.

The local grain market is unusually strong and the demand on this port for outside shipment, especially to Coast points, is large. All grades are quoted strong and there is a likelihood of an early advance. Flour prices are quoted strong in sympathy with the better tone of the grain market, but no advances have been reported since that of in The Journal a week ago.

SEATS ARE LOWER IN STOCK EXCHANGE

Sales Now Being Made at Prices Ranging \$10,000 Under Former Ones.

N. J. June 12, 1903. It is reported that a seat on the Stock Exchange will be sold for \$70,000. The last previous sale was made several months ago for \$30,000. The gross earnings of the United States and Paper Company are said to show an increase of about 10 per cent over last year. The net profits, however, are reported to be about the same as a year ago owing to the increased cost in the operating account. The statement of the Baltimore and Ohio for the month of May mainly shows a high percentage gain, though less than of previous month. Net for 11 months of the fiscal year indicates earnings of 6 1/2 per cent on the stock but as it was not issued until the latter part of the first six months, the earnings on the average capital is at the same percentage of the previous year.

While some little time ago there seemed to be excellent prospects for an increase in the Illinois Central Directory to be declared next month, it now seems probable that the view of the unrest of the stock market and the uncertainty of the future of the Directory will be deferred. The gross earnings for May, which have just been published, show an increase of nearly \$500,000 over the corresponding month last year which must be considered a remarkable exhibit. This is an increase of nearly 12 1/2 per cent as compared with an average increase of 6 1/2 per cent for the 10 months preceding. It is predicted that the year ending will show about 14 per cent earned on the stock and there is a feeling that while nothing may be done in the way of increasing the rate in July, the earnings may justify a higher rate as soon as the outlook principally in regard to labor, becomes clearer.
