GERMAN COURTESY AT KIEL

American Squadron Meets the Warships of the Kaiser and Prince Henry Greets Uncle Sam's Sailors.

Bluejackets Give Exhibition of Baseball Under Circumstances Not the Best for Well-Played Game.

German Sailors Appoint Entertaining Committee and Arrange Good Time for American Cousins.

(Journal Special Service.) KIEL, June 23.—The American squadron, consisting of the battleship Kearsarge and the cruisers Chicago and Cincinnati, arrived here today. They saluted Prince

Henry's flag with 17 guns. The German ship's short batteries replied with a like salute and then the Germans dipped flags and cheered. Official visits were exchanged, after which Prince Henry received the American captains cordially. A shore leave was given the sailors of the two nations, who are now patrolling the streets arm in arm. A more cheerful display of naval courtesies has not gone on record than those exchanged today and which are now going on. Officers and men are as friendly as brothers and one interesting feature was the exhibition at baseball which the American sailors gave to the Germans. Baseball paraphernalia was a little short aboard the American vessels, but the men made out very well under the circumstances.

The German sailors appointed an entertaining committee and tonight will give an enjoyable time to their American cousins.

WALCOTT DIDN'T OBJECT

FORGERS WORKING ENGLAND

Ashton Who Says that He is an American Now on Trial for Forgery Amounting to \$2,100.

Police Attach Much Importance to Arrest and Trial as It is Believed Organized Gang May Be Broken Up.

Ashton a Well-Dressed Man Possessed of Good Education—Is Non-Committal in Regard to Self or Actions.

(Journal Special Service.) LONDON, June 23.—William Ashton, who describes himself as an American journalist, was arraigned this morning and was charged with forging checks on London banks. Two operations men-

tioned in the charge aggregate in amount \$2,100. The prosecution attaches great importance to the arrest, as it believes the work is that of a skillful American gang and a part wreckage of a clever scheme to make a wholesale haul.

Ashton is a well-dressed individual and is possessed of considerable education. He is non-committal in regard to himself and particularly does he refuse to discuss his operations, lest he betray the other members of his gang.
