

HEALTH REPORT FOR LAST MONTH

Shows a Remarkable Change for the Better in the Prevalence of Contagious Diseases in Portland.

Scarlet Fever and Measles Have Decreased Nearly 50 Per Cent—Other Statistics of Public Interest.

The report of the Board of Health for the month of June, issued today, shows a remarkable change for the better in the prevalence of contagious diseases. During May there were 201 cases and in June there were only 133 cases reported. The report indicates an unusual decrease in the prevalence of measles, for in May the inspector was notified of 118 cases and during the past month there were but 59 cases. Scarlet fever reports show a corresponding reduction.

In other ways the June report is satisfactory to those interested in the maintenance of good health. The statistics are as follows:

- Contagious Diseases Reported During Month—Diphtheria, 29; measles, 59; chickenpox, 2; whooping cough, 0; erysipelas, 1; typhoid fever, 5; scarlet fever, 14; smallpox, 28. Births Registered During Month—Male, 97; female, 53; total, 150. Marriage licenses issued by County Clerk during month, 131. Deaths Register During Month—Males, 40; females, 28; total, 68.
