

ACCUSES SOLDIERS OF ROBBERY

Slugged and robbed of \$75 by four soldiers from the Vancouver barracks, is the experience of W. R. Truelock last night. Two of the men he accused, G. M. Stevens and C. G. Fisher, were later arrested, and this morning when arraigned on charges of robbery their cases were continued until tomorrow.

Truelock was formerly a member of the Eighth army corps, and when he met the four blue-coated members of Uncle Sam's army yesterday the acquaintance soon ripened into friendship. The men were together during the afternoon and early evening, during which time they all spent considerable money about saloons.

Shortly after 9 o'clock the party was in the Owl saloon, near Third and Burnside streets. It is said that Truelock was intoxicated at the time. He says he was induced to accompany the soldiers to the yard back of the saloon, where his new friends gave him the "strong arm" and robbed him of \$75, all the money he had left. According to Truelock's story, he was choked and beaten almost into insensibility. One of his assailants slapped him and he fell to the ground, where he lay dazed. After taking from him three \$20 gold pieces, a \$10 coin and a \$5 piece, the robbers ran away.

As evidence of his experience, Truelock today shows a badly battered and broken face.

As soon as notified, Patrolman M. F. Sloan started out to find the highwaymen. From the description he soon picked out a soldier, whom Truelock identified as one of his assailants. About 11:30 o'clock Sloan saw the other three. He succeeded in arresting one, but the other two boarded a car for Vancouver and escaped.

It is believed that three of these soldiers are the men who held up and robbed of \$19 a sailor from the Two Brothers, near the Vancouver barracks, Sunday morning. This tar had been at a dance, where he met the soldiers. They had a few drinks together, and when looking for another bar they led him out onto the beach. There the sailor was slugged and robbed.

SHIPS COLLIDE AND FIVE ARE DROWNED

POLICEMAN BREAKS WOMAN'S FINGER

Mrs. L. B. Le June, who was taken in custody last evening, accused of keeping a gambling house at 87 North Fifth street by the police, says that a captain and three of the officers at headquarters handled her so roughly that they broke her finger.

Captain Gritzmacher, she says, demanded that she put up \$20, for what she did not know. For bail, the captain says.

"I don't know, but will look and see," Mrs. Le June says she answered. As she was about to open her purse the captain and Patrolmen Welch and Vance snatched for her purse. She seized it, and in trying her hand open Welch broke her little finger.

"Little things like that happen often," said Captain Gritzmacher, speaking of the incident. The captain says he held her till the doctor came. She was incarcerated from 2 o'clock in the afternoon until 5 o'clock. In the meantime, she says, her requests to send word to friends for damages and it was not until a late hour that a doctor was called to attend to her injuries. The only relief she could secure was by placing it under a tap of running water.

Mrs. Le June indignantly denies that she resisted the officers or in any way gave them cause to handle her roughly. She interviewed Mayor Williams today on the subject and visited Attorney Hume with a view of bringing action against the officers.

SETTLING ELKS' DAMAGE CLAIMS

Six claim agents are in this city today trying to arrange settlements of claims for damages against the Northern Pacific road resulting from the wreck of the Elks' excursion train near Chehalis last Saturday.

The Elks of the city are making arrangements to secure for the owners all property that was lost at the Chehalis wreck. To this end a man was sent to the scene to bring back all the articles he could find. The Pullman company has some articles picked up there, and as soon as the owners are found they will be distributed.

A stranger brought into Attorney O'Brien's office this morning a pair of glasses that were covered with blood and dirt, which it is thought were the ones worn by the deceased Charles Furlman. All those that lost articles at the wreck are requested to leave a description of them with Mr. O'Brien in the Chamber of Commerce building.

No unfavorable reports were received today from the victims of the accident on the Northern Pacific to the Elks' excursion train last Saturday. Mrs. C. B. Brown, the most seriously injured, who had one of her arms torn off, was reported slightly better at St. Vincent's hospital, and it is now believed that she may recover.

"All are improving slowly," was the statement regarding the others.

RAINS DAMAGE CORN.
