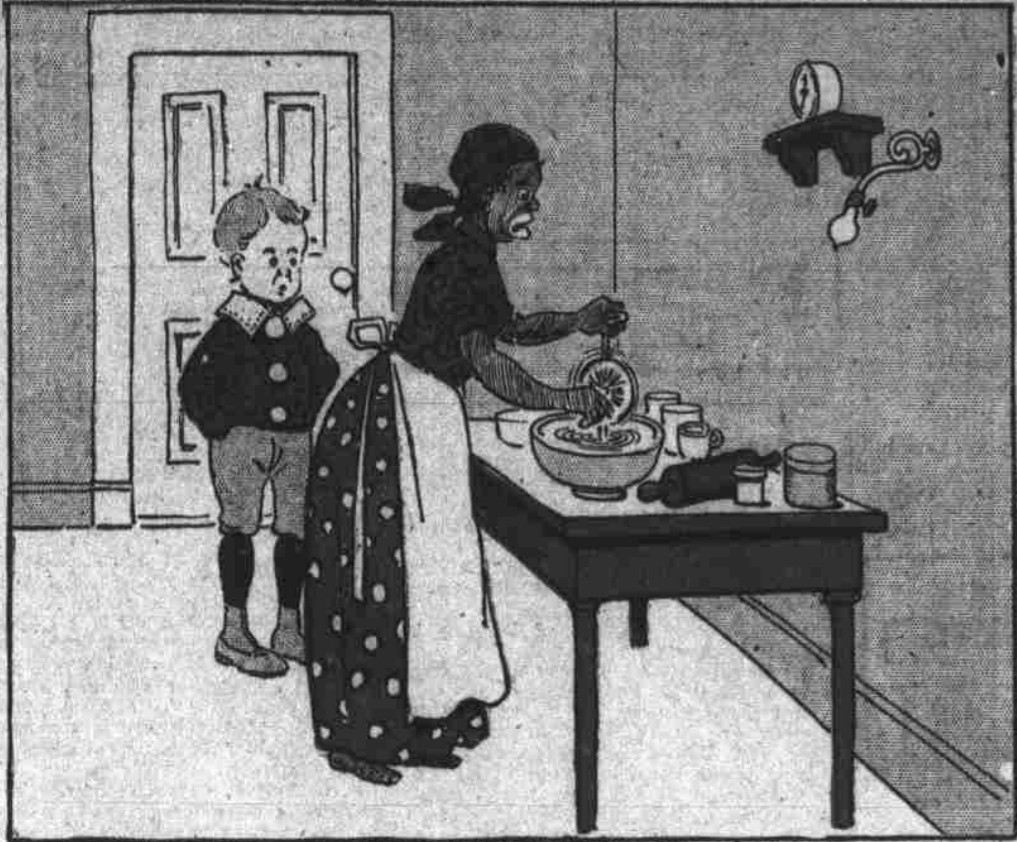
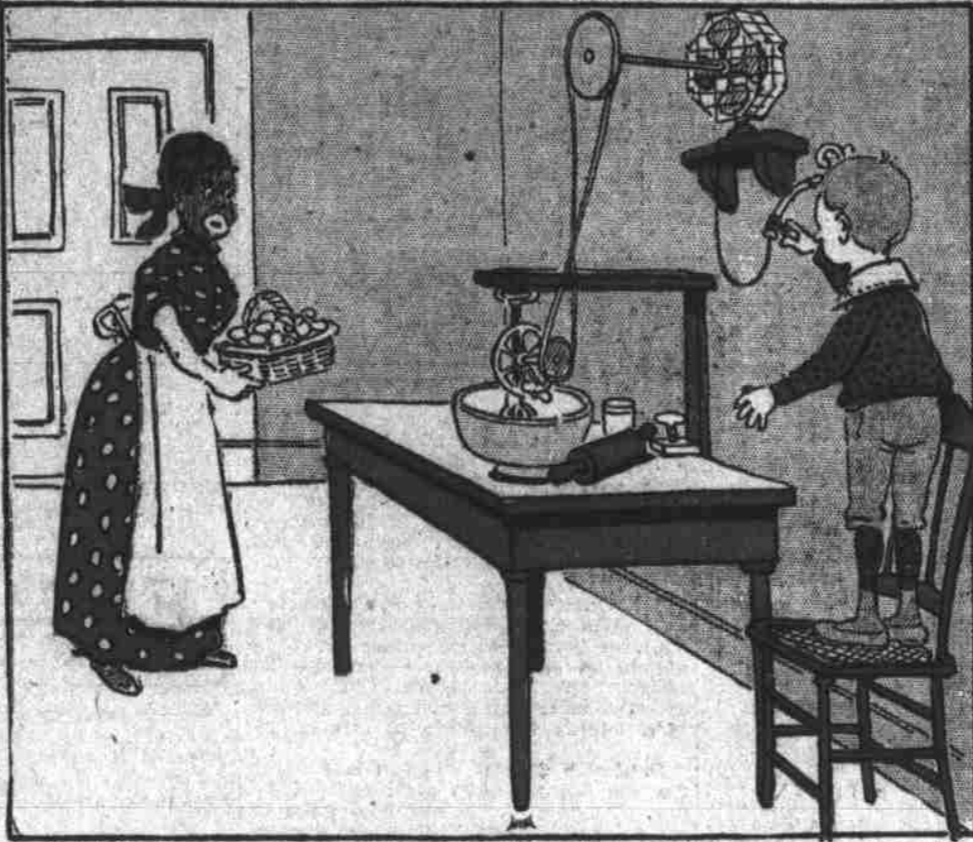

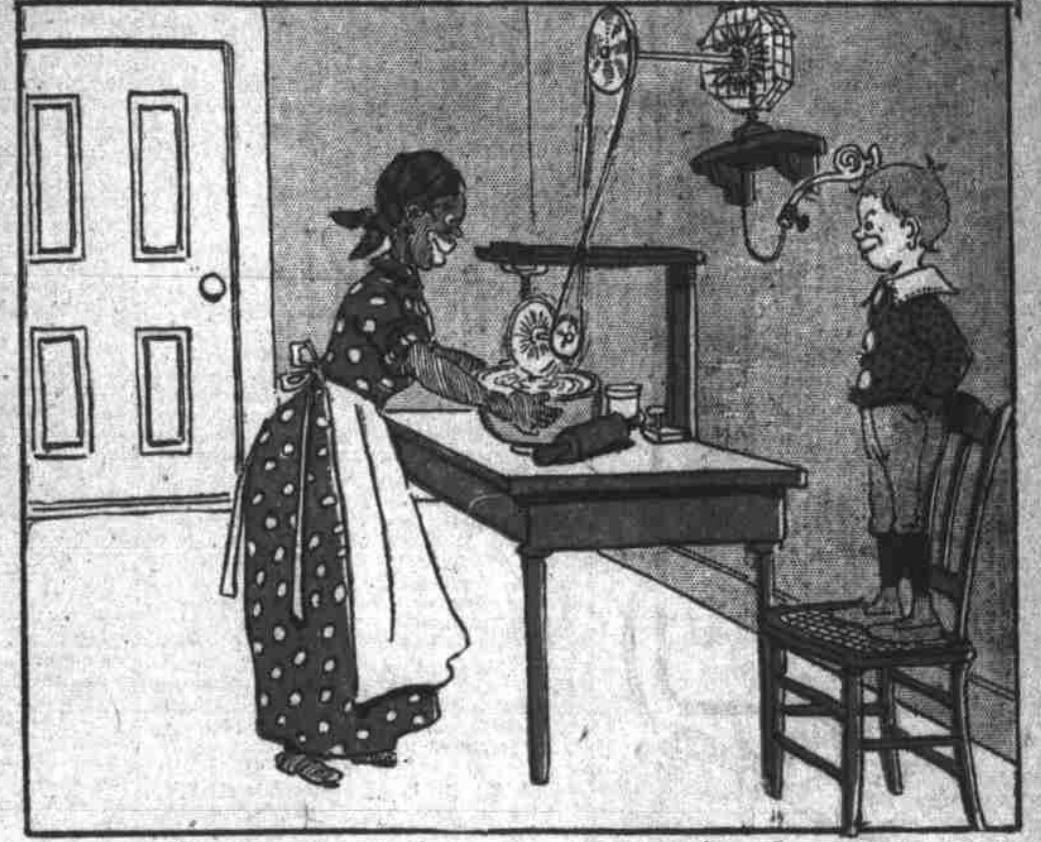
WILLIE WESTINGHOUSE EDISON SMITH INVENTS AN EGGBEATER



Dear Tommy—I was watching Dinah beat eggs the other day, when I got an idea for an eggbeater.



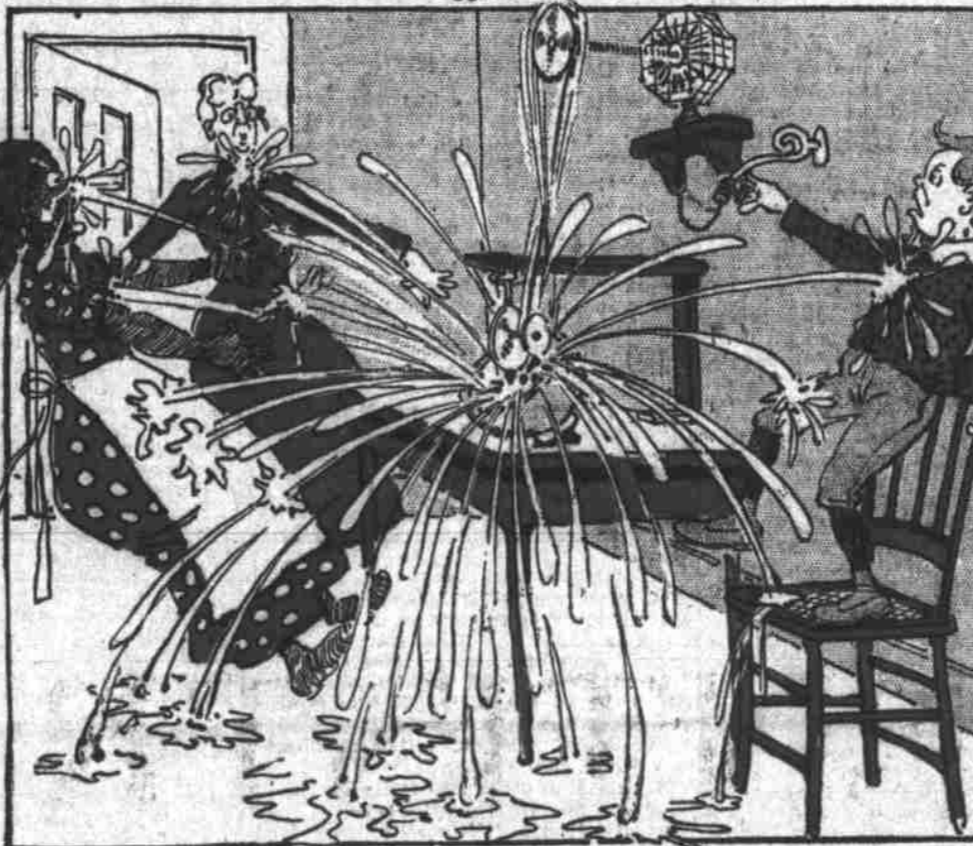
I got an old electric fan from the store and geared it to a wheel on Dinah's eggbeater.

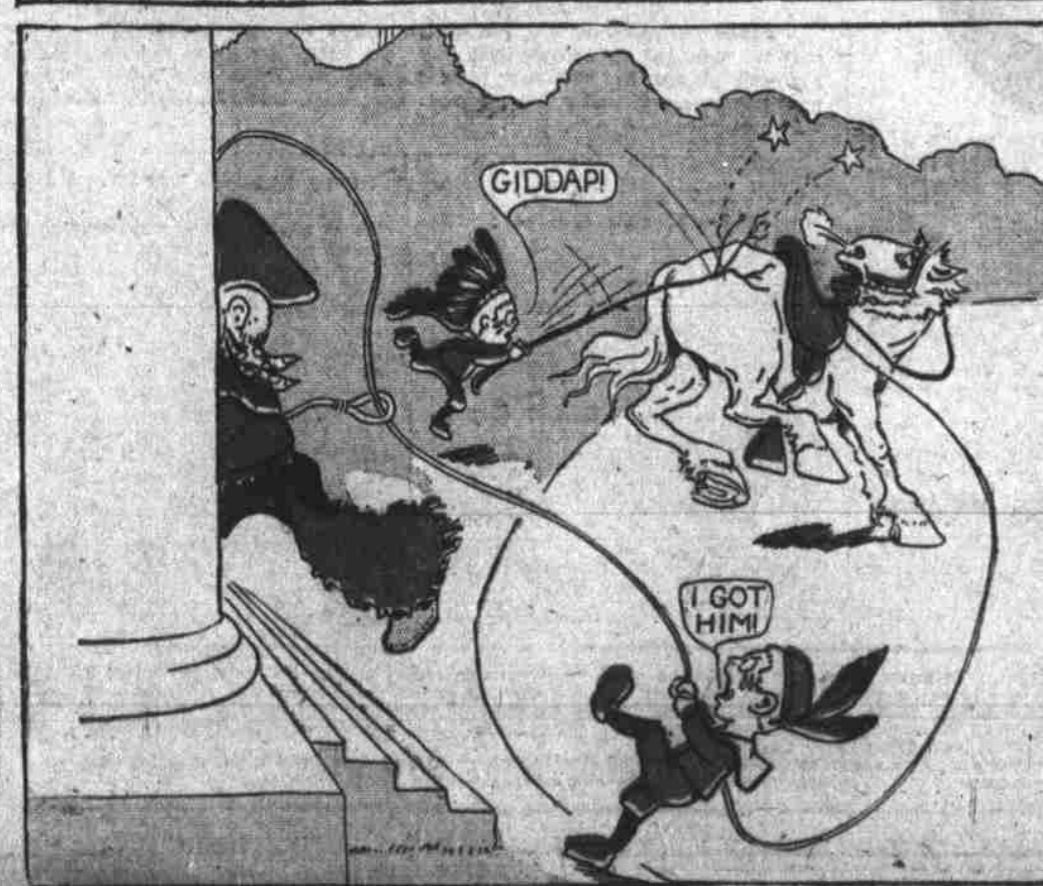

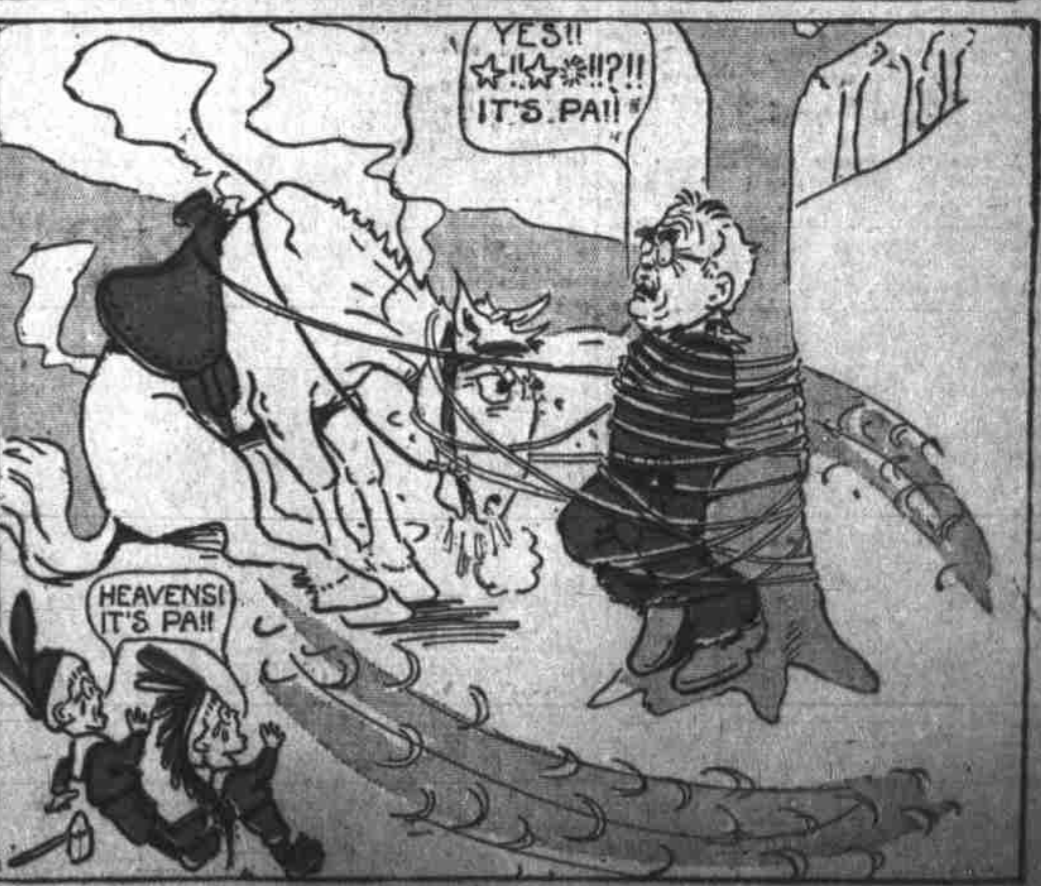
