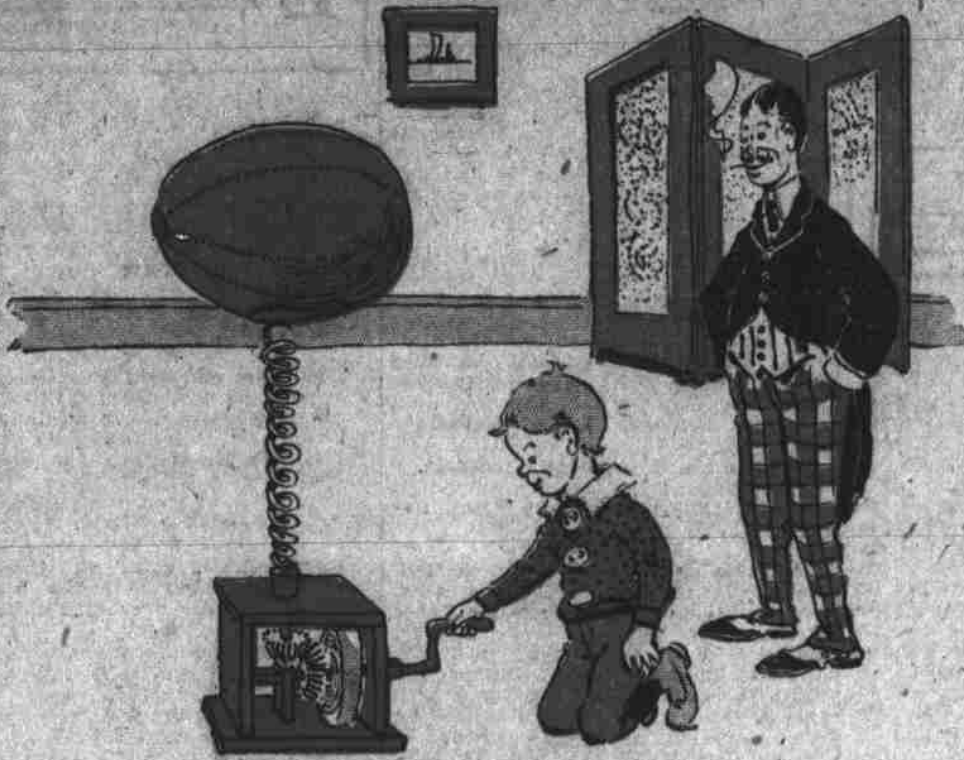
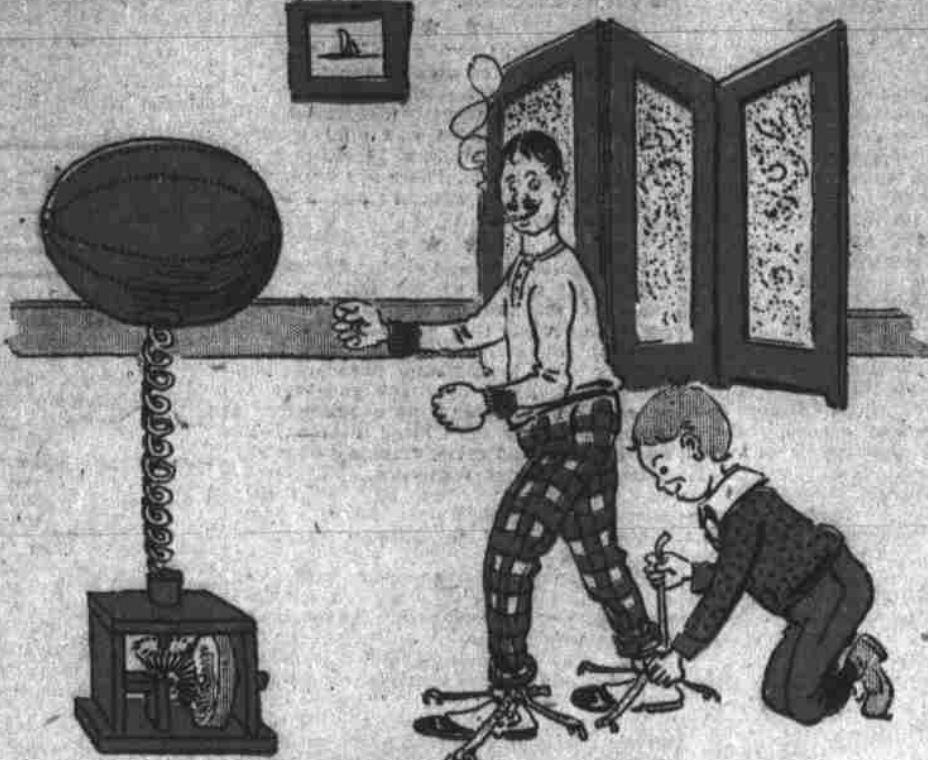

WILLIE WESTINGHOUSE INTRODUCES MAUDE'S BEAU TO A PUNCHING BAG



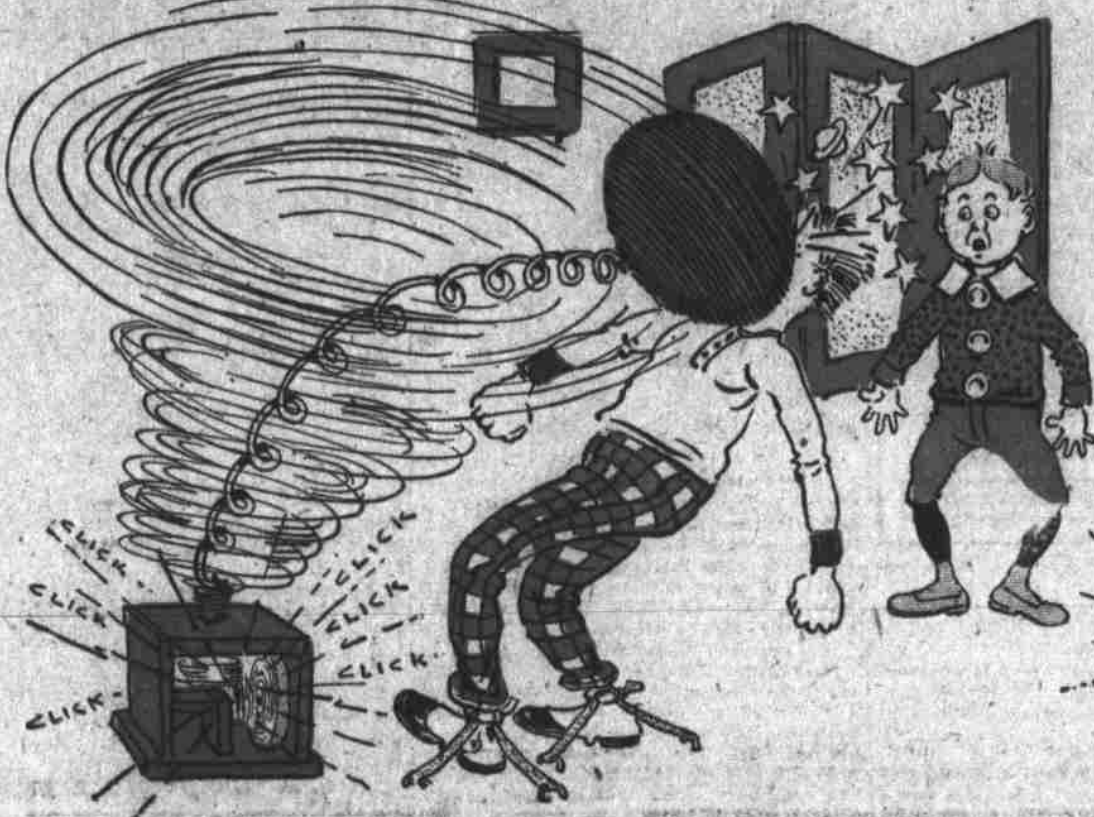
Dear Tommy—I made a whirlingig punching bag for Papa last week.



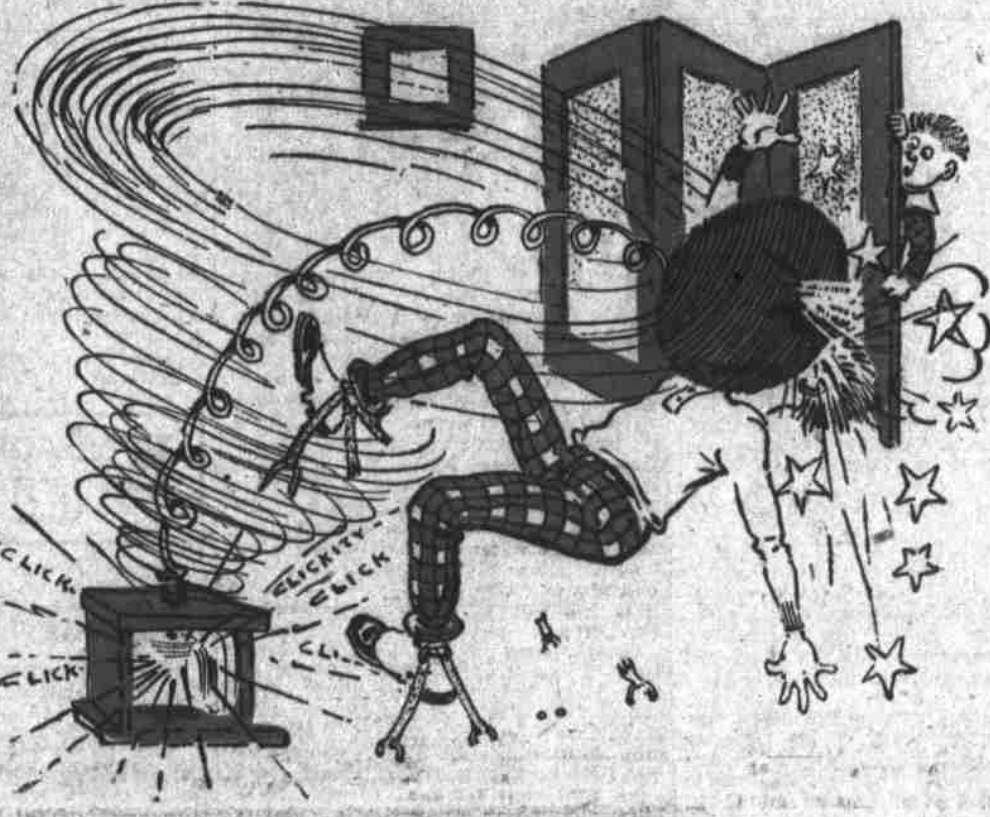
Just as I finished it Maude's beau came in, and wanted to try it.
