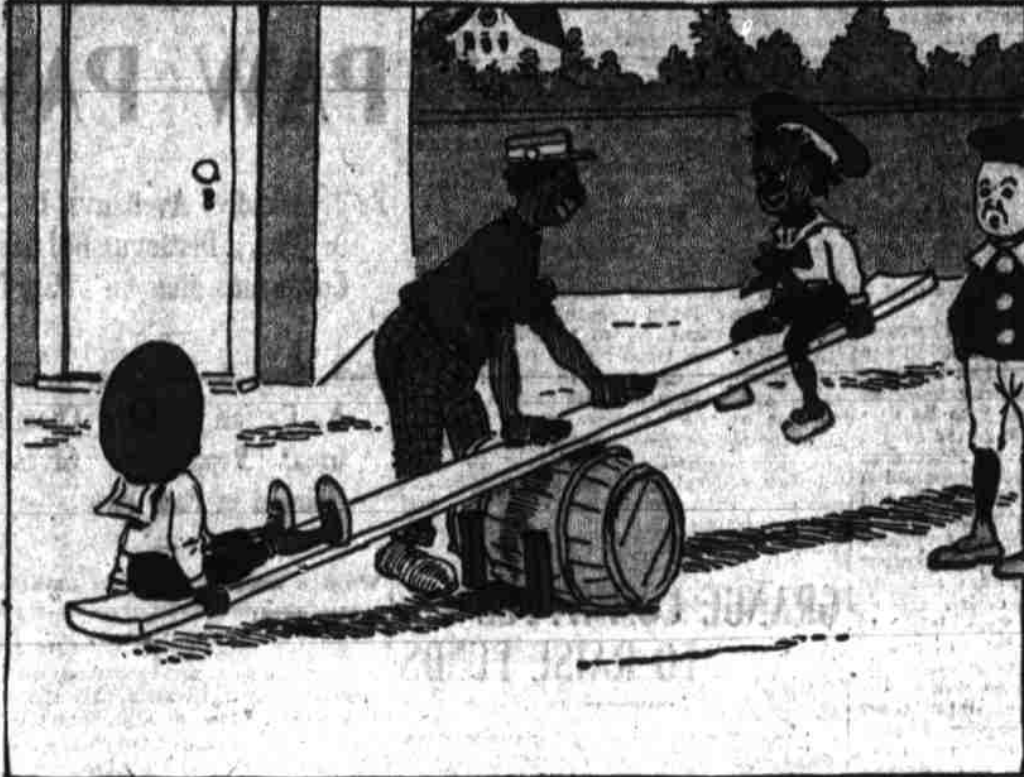
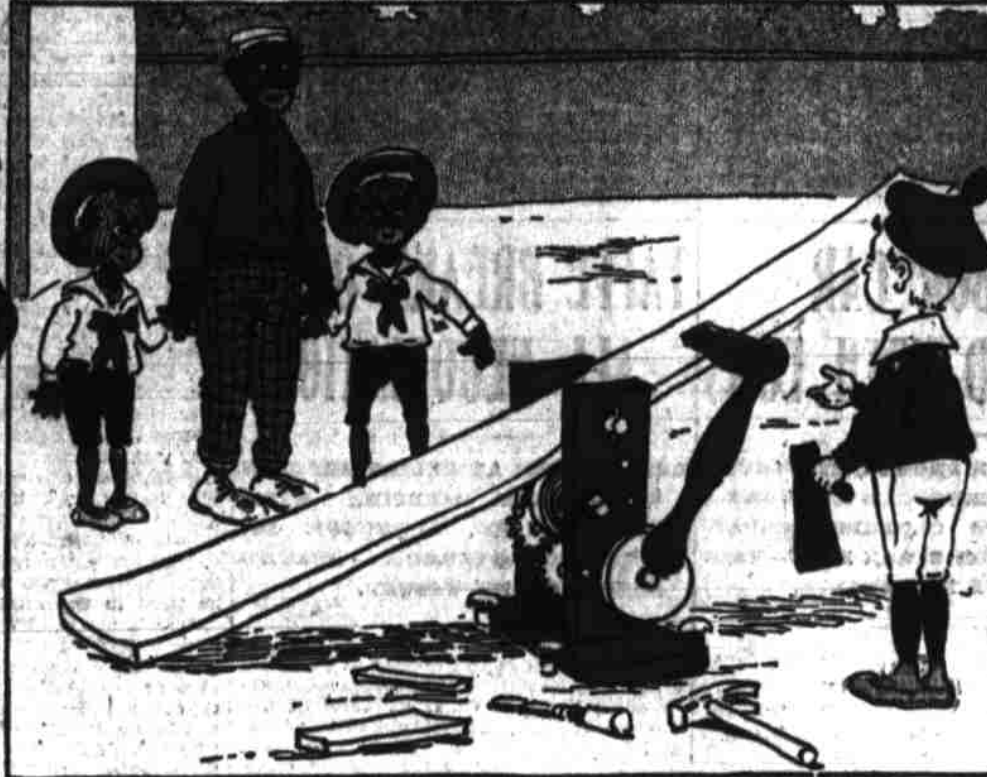

# WILLIE WESTINGHOUSE INVENTS AN AUTOMATIC SEE-SAW



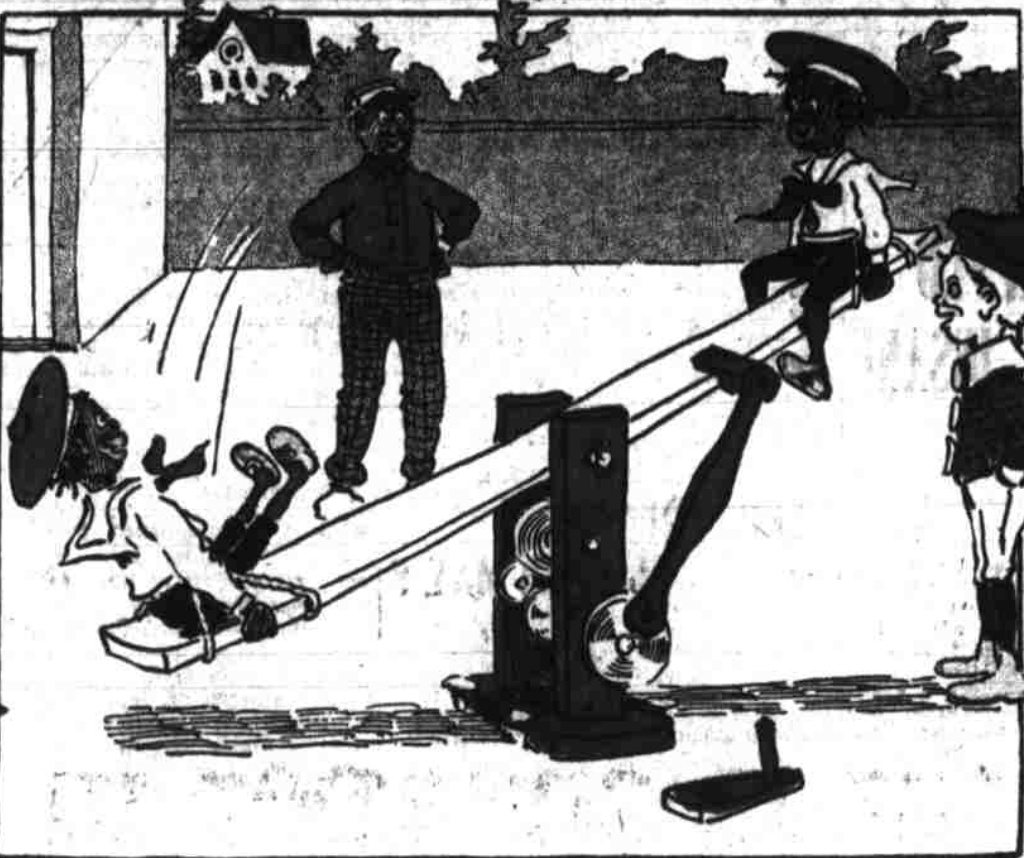
Dear Tommy—When Jim's wife is out he has to mind the twins. He had fixed up a see-saw for them behind the barn.



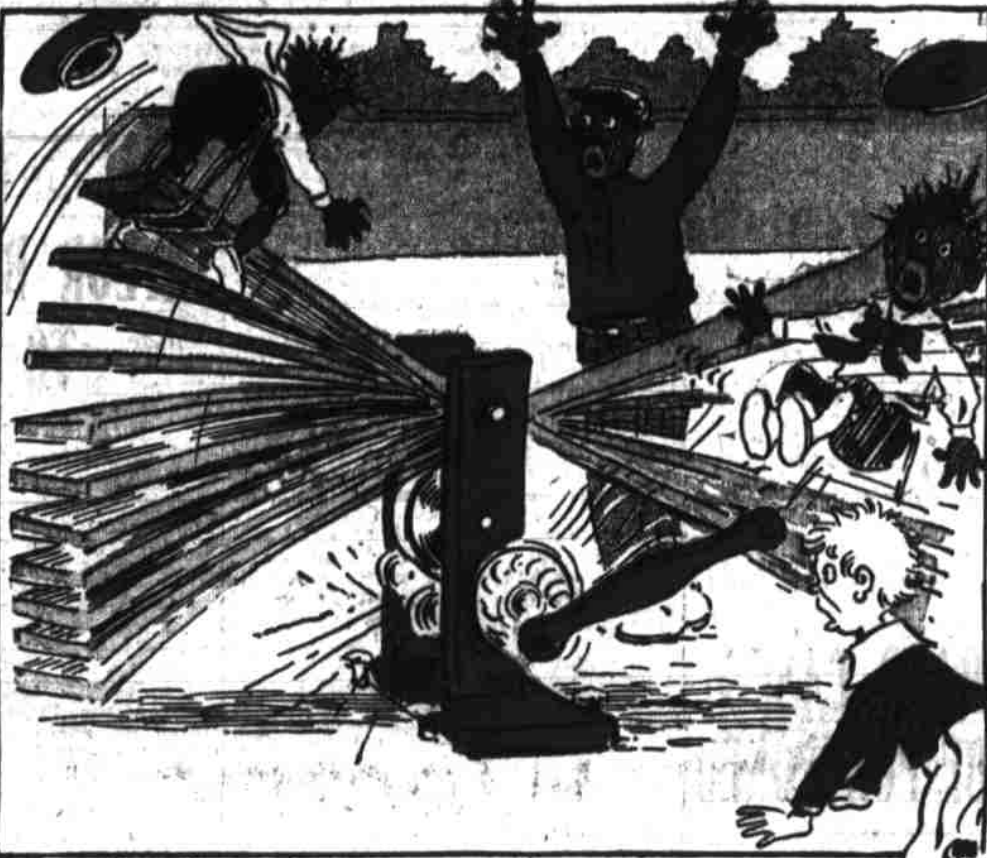
They liked it so much that I built one to run with a spring.



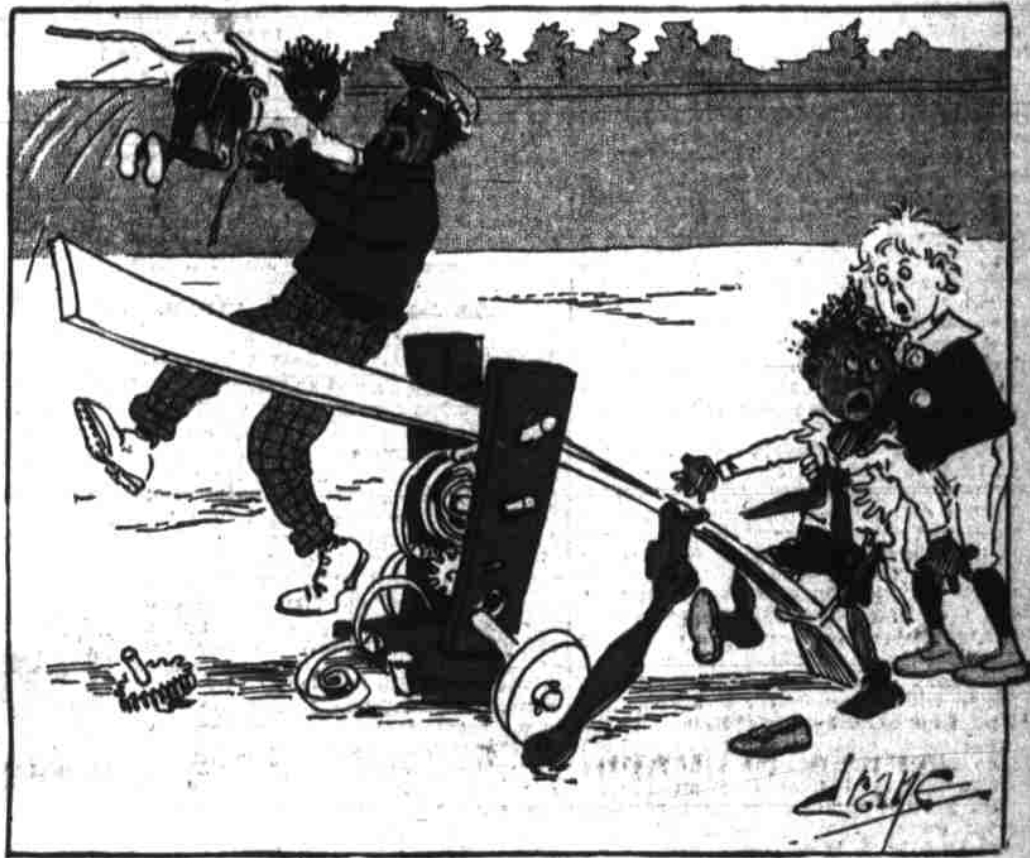
We strapped the twins on and started her off.
