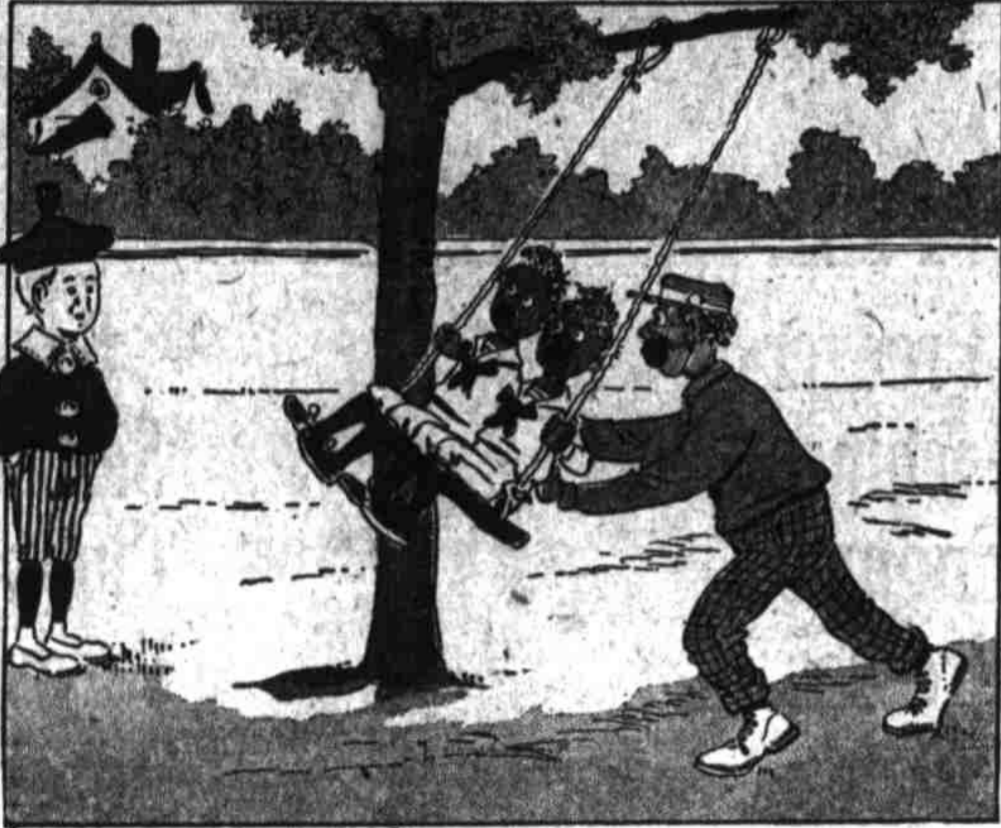
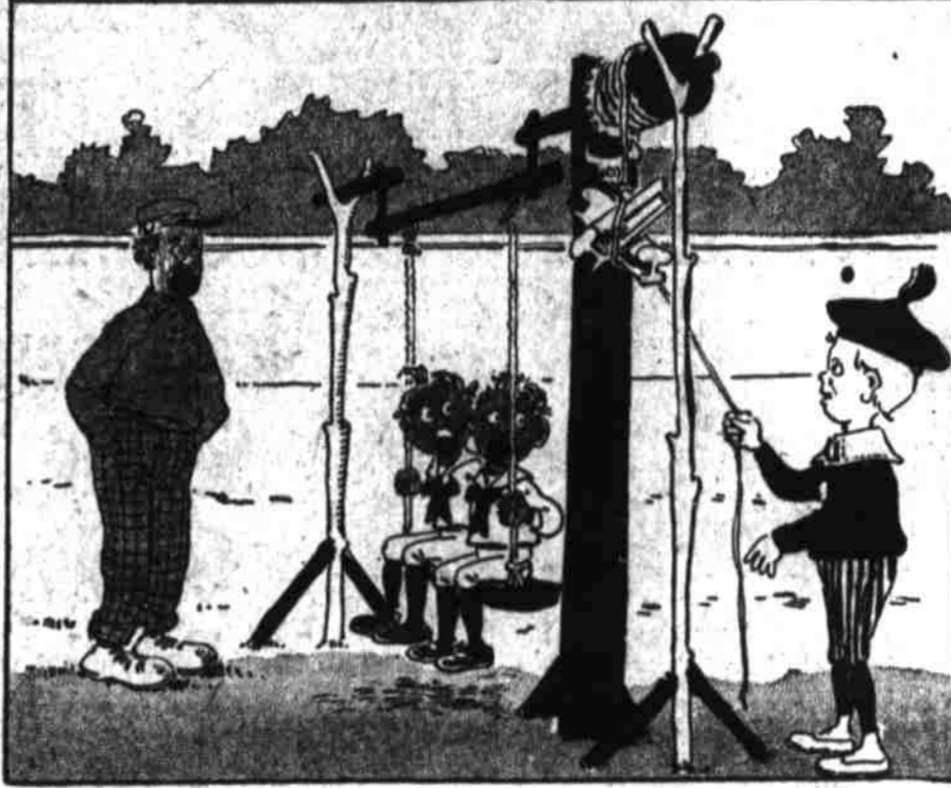

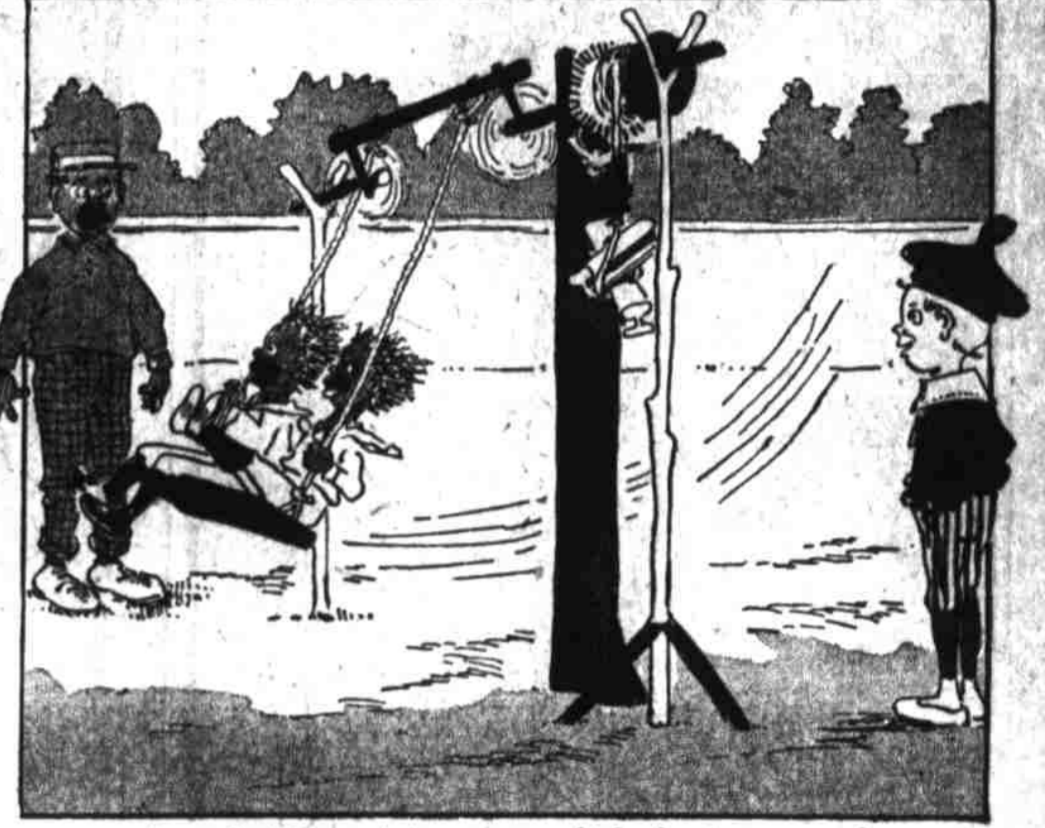
WILLIE HELPS THE TWINS ENJOY A SWING



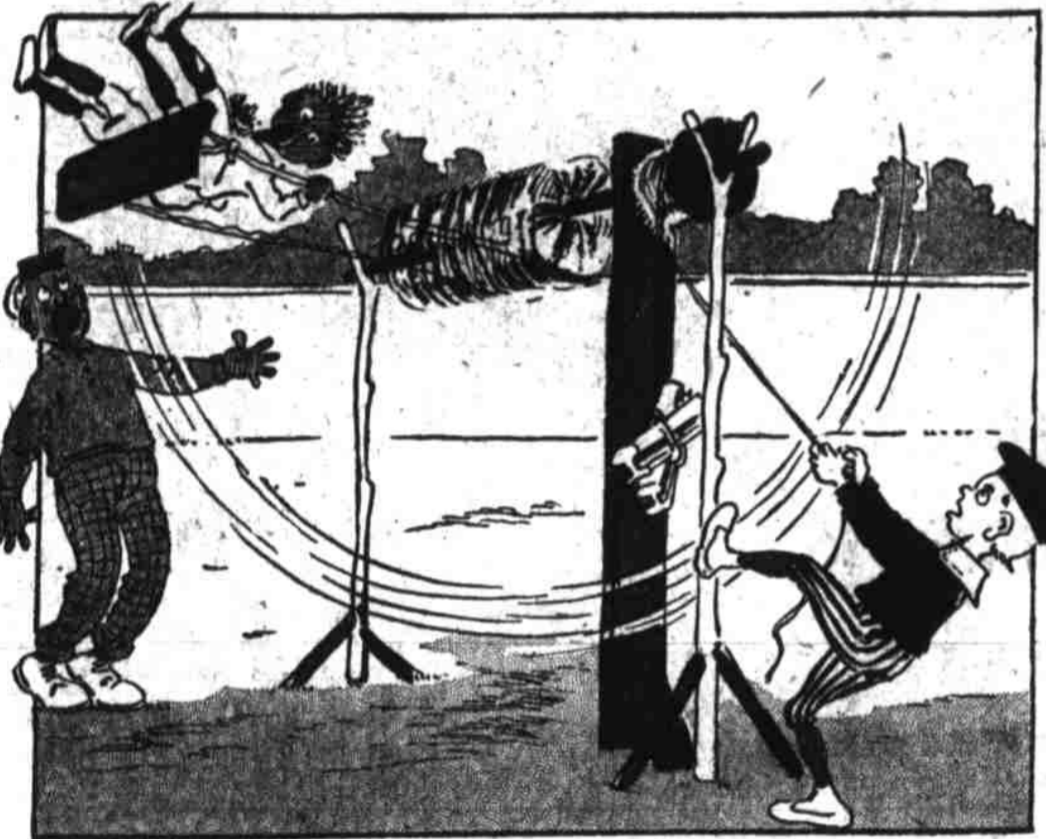
Dear Tommy—Jim fixed up a swing for the twins—



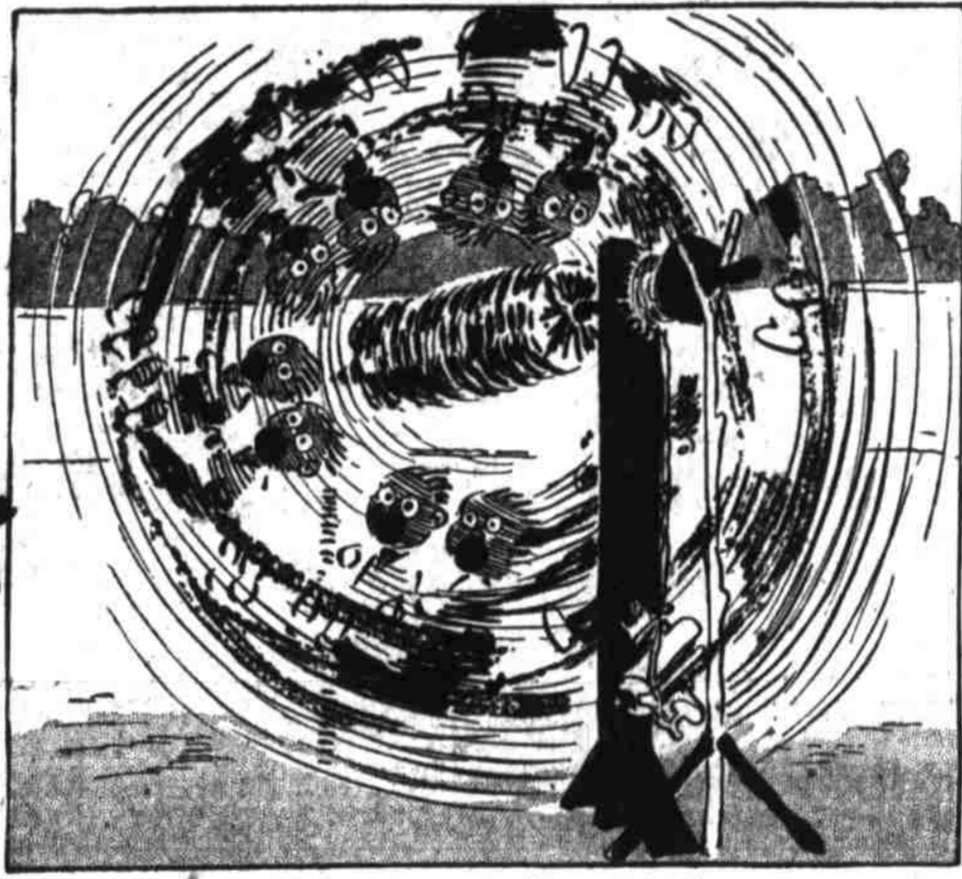
And they liked it so well that I made one to work automatically.



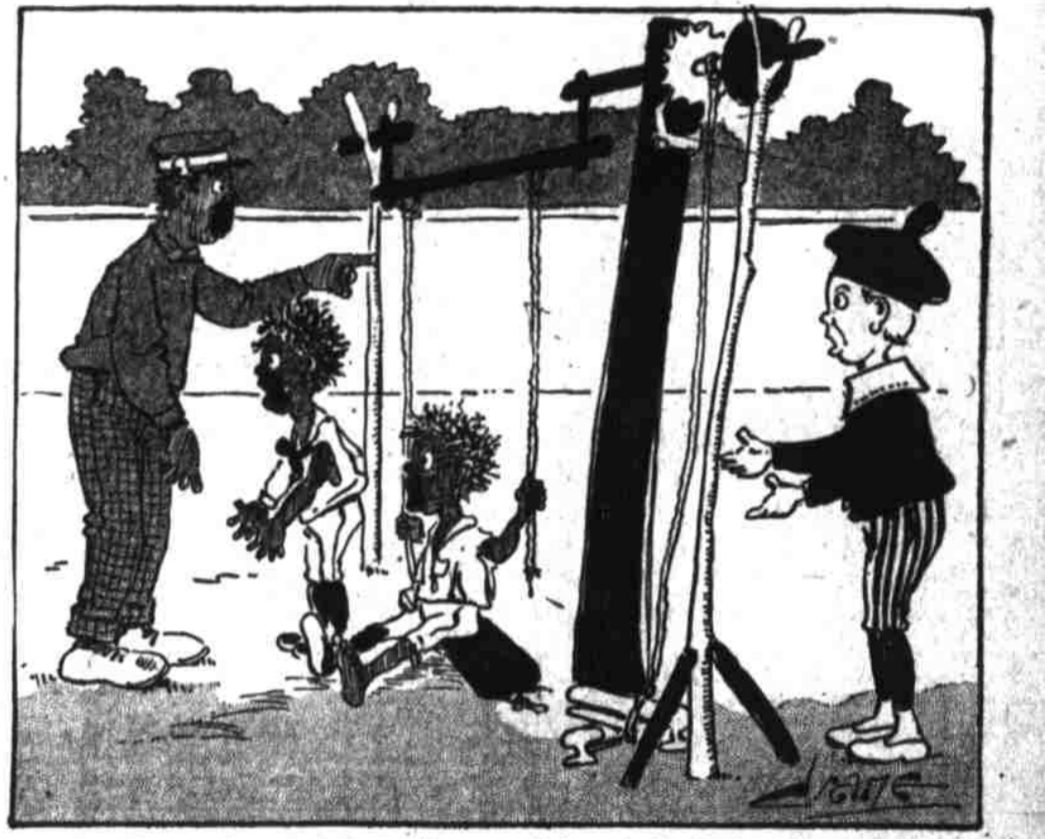
It worked fine, only it swung too high after it got started.
