Dressed Hogs and Veal Are Higher. During the week the scarcity of both dressed hogs and veal caused the prices on both products to advance 1/4 cent a pound.

Chittim Bark Is Dull and Lower. Up to the end of the week there was a slight uptick in the market for chittim bark and some of them were paying as high as 6 1/2c.

Japanese Sending Orders for Flour. Orders for flour are now being received by the local millers from Japan, but they are in soft straits for vessels in which to ship.

New Wheat Is Coming in Slowly. New wheat of all grades is coming into market very slowly, but considerable buying has been done by the millers.

Poultry Demand Was Improved. All through the week there was a good demand for all sorts of poultry, with the exception of geese, and the receipts were very small.

Cabbage Was Very Scarce. There was a great scarcity of cabbage in the markets this week and prices moved higher. New potatoes of good quality are not coming fast enough.
