Front Street, August 12.—The principal feature of the Portland wholesale market today are the flour stocks.

Millers Pay Premium for Wheat. In the interior the smaller millers in order to get a sufficient amount of stocks are paying a premium of from 1 to 3c a bushel on valley wheat in order to secure immediate deliveries.
