Every day adds to the number of eastern cities which are seeking to buy flour in this market.

According to one of the large mill men of this city the mills of this territory—the larger ones at least—have already received orders from the east to keep their mills grinding at full time for practically three months.

In response to the heavy demand upon this market, the millers have advanced their quotations for eastern shipment 10 cents a barrel, or to \$3.60.

Just now there is but little demand from the east, but some inquiries are being received and some shipments will very likely begin about the middle of next month.

Dollar wheat in this city before the next crop is harvested is now being frequently predicted, on account of the heavy milling demand from the east and the large orders for flour from that source.

There is no abatement of the heavy demand for Oregon wheat from this market, as in that form there will be a large volume of freight.
