PRUNE MARKET IS UNSATISFACTORY

NOTWITHSTANDING SMALL GROUP
CARROTTERS ARE SUFFICIENT
TO KEEP PRICES AT LOWEST
LEVEL—SALE UP ½ CENT
CONTINUED HIGH DRIED AMOUNTS.

Frank Street, Nov. 1.—The principal features of the market were the following today are: Good demand for dried prunes. Market is higher. Prices being cleaned up fast. Prices are very low. Shipping wheat on old contracts. Potatoes are firm. Vary well advanced. Sheep market open. Good demand for dressed hogs. Barley in better demand.

Dried Prunes Rule in Prunes.

The prune market this year is a very difficult one to be satisfied. The production everywhere was very small, but the heavy carry-over from last year has kept the price down to the lowest possible levels. Very few of the large packing houses are in operation in this state this season on account of the number of packers who have gone out of the states of Idaho and Washington. The canning of the three northwest states last season is placed at \$60,000,000 pounds by J. W. Atter, while the output this season will not likely exceed 10,000,000 pounds.

One of the chief reasons for this curtailment of production was the early frost which began especially late in the Willamette valley and where the crop last year is only estimated at 10,000,000 pounds.

Notwithstanding the small amount of production, there should be made by dried, peeled, dried, dried and small amounts are available in a fair condition.
