Poleless 'Thome Wires.


Last March occurred the highest and most dangerous floods of water containing lee, snow and wreckage on the various rivers of the middle west that has happened within the memory of the oldest inhabitant. It was owing to the unusually long and severe winter, which brought misery and suffering to the thousands throughout the various central and northern states, and in the spring brought havoc and danger to the people along the river bottoms.
