ADMIRAL TERRY GOES ON LIST OF RETIRED

(Journal Special Service.) Washington, Dec. 28.-The United States navy loses a valuable and popular officer in the person of Rear Admi-ral Silas Wright Terry, who was placed ral Silas Wright Terry, who was placed on the retired list today by operation of the age limit. Admiral Terry is now on his way here from the far east.

Admiral Terry retires with a grand record as a fighting sailor in Uncle Sam's service. He entered the Naval academy in 1838 from Kentucky, and went through the civil war with extraordinary valor. He was in the Red river expedition as commander of the transport Benefit. Admiral Porter, in a letter to the secretary of the mavy, wrote several hundred words of the highest praise of Terry, who was then an ensign. The president advanced the young man five numbers in his grade for the gallant work he did on that expedition. In 1864 he was placed on Admiral Porter's staff and served in that rapacity until the end of the war. The past 30 years of Admiral Terry's life have been spent in shifting from one post to amother in the naval service. During the past year he has served as naval compast year he has served as naval com-mandant at Honolulu.

Chattanooga. Dec. 28.—The body of Capt. Howard W. French, constructing quartermaster of the new army post at Chickamauga park, was found this morning near a stone quarry. He had been shot through the heart. It is believed that he was murdered, either for motives of robbery or revenge.

Capt. Howard W. French was well known in this locality. He came to Vancouver barracks from the Philippines in 1991, after about two years of service in the islands as a member of the Seventeenth infantry. After leaving here he became a member of the quartermaster's department and has been statiqued at Chattanooga ever since.
