ROSE BEATS RECORD FOR PUTTING SHOT

Many Preliminaries Before Work Can Begin on the Proposed Structure.

NEARLY TWO YEARS MAY BE REQUIRED FOR WORK

Director Wittenberg Talks of Some of the Things That Will Cause Delay.

H. Wittenberg, member of the board of school directors, is of the opinion that it will be more than a year before the proposed high school is finished.

Before any bond issue can be taken up by the board of education, a petition must be circulated asking that the district be bonded.

When the bond issue is prepared, their legality will have to be passed upon before they can be offered for sale.

"In my opinion the high school is finished and ready for occupancy by September 1, 1906, we will have lost no time and will have done a good work."

Mr. Wittenberg further stated that in all probability a building to cost to exceed \$100,000 will be erected. It will be modern in every detail, and will be large enough to accommodate 100 or 800 students.
