Freezing temperatures occur this morning in the Gulf states, a minimum of 28 degrees at New Orleans, 18 degrees at Atlanta and 32 degrees at Jacksonville.

The indications are for 32 to 34 degrees. This morning, conditions are favorable for a fair weather to the west of this range. It will be cooler tonight in western Oregon. Weather will be warm and dry in the eastern portions of these states and Idaho.
