Goes Over the Record of His Office in a Financial Way.

DECLARES HIS CLAIMS SHOULD BE ALLOWED

Denounces as Absurd the Assertion That He is Spending Too Much Money.

"I do not desire to get into a petty quarrel with the county court or with anyone else," said Sheriff Word today.

"No, I have exactly as many office deputies as Sheriff Storey had, notwithstanding the immense increase in business this year."

"If any think I am disposed to put the people to unnecessary expense, I will tell them that I have been running the tax department with 20 men, against \$3 kept by my predecessor at an expense of \$300 less a month than it was under Sheriff Storey."

"I am willing to pass the issue up to the people, as to whether or not they think I am honest in my demands, and am disposed to attend to their business as it should be attended to."

"That he has paid the county for his expenses asked for, in his contention, leaving a substantial balance to his credit."
