WINTER FAVORABLE FOR GRAIN CROP

RESEEDING FULLY MAKES UP FOR ALL LOSSES

Season Much Earlier Than Usual—Hops Showing a Very Good Growth to Date.

United States department of agriculture, climate and crop bulletin for the week ending Monday, April 10:

The winter was favorable for fall-sown crops of grain and grasses, except in a few scattered localities in the eastern sections, where the cold weather in February killed some grain that was not well protected by snow.

Several frosts occurred during the past few days and fruit, which some generally in bloom, has suffered to some extent; reports as to the amount of damage are conflicting, but apparently peaches have been injured the most.

Point Terrace, Lane county, S. J. Allison—Weather warm and spring-like; farmers busy planting gardens; early gardens doing well; cherries, plums, pears, peaches, currants and some apricots in full bloom; grass growing nicely; all stock in good condition.

Myrtle Point, Coos county, L. Strong—Weather rather cool, but suitable for farming operations; grain and grass at about one month earlier than usual; considerable plowing being done; a greater number of creameries running now than usual; stock in good condition; fruit prospects good; berries in bloom; peaches early; garden work fine.

Wendy, Clackamas county, F. R. Meling—Fall grain is extra good and spring sown is growing nicely; weather very favorable for spring sowing; potato planting progressing rapidly; fruit promising; grass growing fast.
