

SALEMAN PRICES HAVE BEEN MADE

Conference of Columbia River Packers Makes the Values Same as Before

SEASON'S PACK VERY UNCERTAIN TO DATE

Hops Are Selling at Advance—Eggs Are on the Fence—Strawberries Better.

Front Street, April 22.—The principal features of the Portland wholesale market today are:

Almonds prices are open. Receipts of almond larger. Hops are selling at advance. Eggs are on the fence. Strawberries are better. Fruit market quiet.

Salmon Prices Are Open. The opening price on Columbia river chinook salmon are unchanged from those of the previous week. The prices were made yesterday at the office of the Columbia River Packers Association at Astoria.

Antonia, April 22.—The packers of the Columbia river district met here late yesterday afternoon and fixed prices for the present season. The meeting was held at the general office of the Columbia River Packers Association and was attended by practically all of the packers of the Columbia river district.

The prices agreed upon for the opening are identical with those fixed last year. For state the price was set at \$1.50 a dozen; for falls, \$1.75 for half, \$2.00 for whole. An additional charge of 8 cents a dozen was agreed upon for key cans.

One of the packers attending the meeting assured the representative of The Journal that the meeting was most harmonious, and that it was unanimously agreed by the packers that the price should be the same as last season.

With reference to the condition of the market for salmon, who have had a very good season, the representative stated this morning that the prospects were bright for a profitable season.

The supply of fish this far is poor, as is usually the case, but the quality is, according to packers, better than ever before at this season of the year.

Yeast Market Quiet in Bloom. The yeast market is in the worst possible condition. There is but little demand from any source, and even those who do want to buy are being forced to accept lower prices.

Two Cows Oroville Potatoes Arrive. Two cars of Oroville potatoes are in the market and are selling at a shade above the figure as the local stock. About five acres are now due from Minnesota. They will likely be directed to San Francisco.
