Transport Hurries Away to San Francisco After Landing Soldiers.

ONE OF THE LARGEST VESSELS EVER HERE

Much Bigger Than the Buford-Officers Entertained Visitors Last Night and Today.

As soon as the soldiers' baggage has seen removed this afternoon the United states transport Sheridan will leave or San Francisco, after having been port in the neighborhood of only 30 cours. With the exception of a small etachment of men left on guard duty, he soldiers were taken to Vancouver esterday on the river steamers Tahoma and Mascot. Pacing back and forth on the dock alongside of which the transport is lying may be seen a sunrowned veteran with a Mauser thrown yer his shoulder. He is there to see hat no soldiers go ashore without a ermit and that no stowaways get board.

The Sheridan is one of the largest ansports that ever came to this port, he is almost 75 feet longer than the uford, which was recently here. The samer is 447 feet long, 49 feet beam of 5,830 gross register tons. At the reaking out of the Spanish-American ar she was the Atlantic liner Massausetts. The government purchased, of in 1838, and converted her into an ansport. In 1991 she was placed in rvice carrying troops back and forth tween San Francisco and Manila. The Sheridan has been steadily in munission since January 25, when she fit the Bay City for Manila with a signment of feed and stores. 


