MONTAVILLA HAS DESTRUCTIVE FIRE

Two Houses in Mansfield Consumed and Half-Dozen More Narrowly Escape.

NO PROTECTION FOR HOMES OR BIG BLOCKS

Chemical Tanks and Hand Grenades the Only Means of Fighting Flames.

Montavilla yesterday had a foretaste of what a fire will mean to it unless some protection is secured, when two houses in Mansfield, a suburb half a mile to the south, burned to the ground and endangered half a dozen more dwellings.

For a time it looked as though half a dozen other houses would also go as there was a high wind blowing at the time and the flames spread to adjoining fences and out houses.

Montavilla is in the same situation as Mansfield, there are no water mains of any size, no fire plugs, nothing larger than a garden hose in the place, and the only available fire apparatus is a box of hand grenades and a few small chemical tanks.

Insurance rates have been raised in the place until they are more than 5 per cent in many cases, and the restrictions are so numerous that hardly an alteration can be made without adding 1 per cent to the rate for the altered building.
