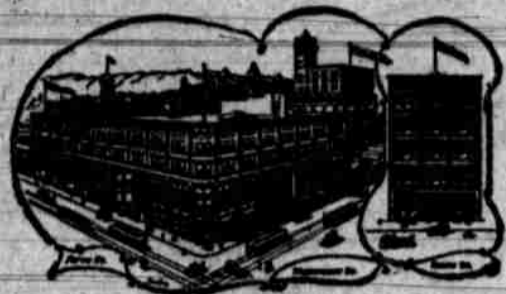

STANDING OF CANDIDATES AT TIME OF COUNT ON TUESDAY, P. M.
