**OREGON SHEEPMEN ARE MAKING FORTUNES**

"From Shaniko 270 cars of sheep have been shipped this spring," said R. B. Wilson, traveling agent of the Burlington, and from Hopper 170 cars. Not much wool has moved, as the season was late and shearing was delayed. Oregon range sheep are in favor with Wyoming and Montana breeders. About 350 sheep are shipped to a car, so that the 40 cars carried approximately 140,000 head to Montana and Wyoming. Prices are \$2.25 for yearling ewes, which are regarded as top prices for those classes.

**DON'T BURN BRUSH UNTIL THE FALL**

F. I. McKenna Makes Strong Plea for Sweet Atmosphere and Clear Skies.

**DOESN'T WANT SCENERY OBSCURED BY SMOKE**

Suggests That Governor and Fair Officials Warn the People Against Forest Fires.

Men interested in the advancement of Portland and Oregon urge the people to delay burning stumps, timber and brush until next October, so that the skies may be clear and visitors from the east may see the beauties of Oregon scenery.
