Our plumbing inspector, Mr. Hulme, said Mayor Lane today, seems to have held his job forever, and indications of his growing weary are invisible to the naked eye.

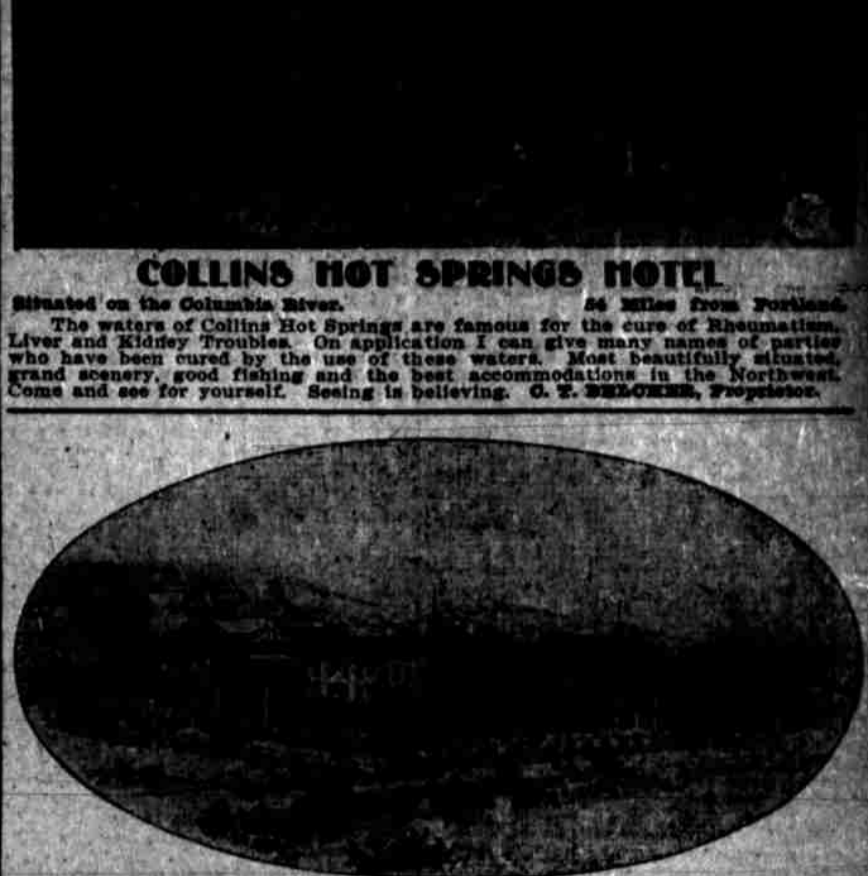
