Council and Business Men Become Aroused to Need of Protection.

MONEY IS ON HAND TO SECURE APPARATUS

Though Volunteers Ready to Organize Efficient Force and Water Supply on Main Street Thought to Be Adequate for an Emergency.

Recent disastrous fires in Portland and the suburbs have stirred Milwaukee citizens, and it is probable that at the council meeting next Monday night a plan will be adopted to secure protection for the business district at least.

Over the years the town has escaped serious damage through good luck, but councilmen believe that luck of this sort will not be the order of things here, and that some protection must be secured at once.

The town's water supply is adequate, but except for one large wooden main in the principal street there is hardly enough water piped to the residences to meet a fire demand, and even along the central main the pressure is not what it should be, as a gravity system is in use and no provision is made for direct pressure from the pumps.

Except for the garden variety of pump there is nothing in the town to convey a stream of water from the mains, and the few hydrants would be useless. The business men of the place will aid the council in its effort to secure apparatus, and there are volunteers enough to form a fire company.

BETTER SERVICE GIVEN.

With the Push Club Waxed and Car Facilities Are Doubled.

Though adequate service cannot be given the Mount Scott residents until a double track is laid from the Mount Water Power company's line to Lewis, such an act can be given under the present arrangement has been afforded this week by the management. WATER SERVICE BETTER.
