BOYCOTT AFFECTS THE EXPORTS

Flour Shipments to China Have Greatly Decreased in the Past Month. ALL THE COAST POINTS FEEL THE PROHIBITION. Many Orders for Foodstuffs Have Been Canceled Here and on the Sound, and Shippers See No Relief in Sight.

Owing to the Chinese boycott against American products flour shipments to the orient have decreased the past month from every port on the Pacific coast. In a table prepared by the merchants' exchange it is shown that in August 13,392 barrels of flour were sent from Portland to the far east against 52,071 barrels exported for the corresponding month last year.

BIG FLEET COMING.

More Tonnage on Way for Carbons Than Has Been Engaged in Years. Thirty-five vessels, suitable for grain carriers and representing a net register tonnage of 69,466, are listed and en route for Portland; it is the greatest amount of tonnage that has been headed for the Columbia river at this season of the year since 1902.

ALONG THE WATERFRONT.

In three weeks the dredge Columbia will complete the work of cutting a ship channel through Slaughter's bar and will proceed to other points down the river where bars formed. The dredge Portland is digging a channel between Vancouver and the mouth of the Willamette river and is making rapid progress.
