\$2,000,000 TO SHORTEN ROAD 10 MILES

Union Pacific to Build Short Cut Through High Hills and Over Long Gulch.

(Journal Special Service.)
Omaha, Sept. 29.—In order to save 10 miles of trans-continental route, the Union Pacific has decided upon the expenditure of over \$2,000,000 to build a new line from South Omaha, for a distance of 18 miles, to Elkhorn. Engineers who have just completed surveys had instructions to run a straight line with minimum grade, regardless of hills and valleys.
The survey shows a cut 60 feet deep, where the cutoff leaves the present line at the Omaha end, another cut a few miles further of 30 feet deep. A short distance further there is a fill one mile long and 20 feet high and it will be necessary to carry the road over a creek. It will require \$400,000 to build this mile, exclusive of the bridge. The cutoff will be double-tracked the entire distance. The line will be built as soon as possible.
