Construction of Riparia-Lewiston Line of O. R. & N. Progressing Satisfactorily.

THREE STEAM SHOVELS USED IN BUILDING ROAD

Rock Work Being Carried on the Northern Pacific's North Bank Line and Grading Contractors Ready to Start Work on Subcontracts.

Construction of the Riparia-Lewiston line of the Oregon Railroad & Navigation company is progressing satisfactorily. Chief Engineer G. W. Boschke, who has been giving his personal attention to the work, returned last night after a week's absence.

There are 636 men on the contractor's payroll, and three steam shovels are in operation. The line runs along the bank of the Snake river, and boats are used in transporting supplies and equipment. The work is being done in detached sections, and the first 15 miles from Riparia will be connected up by the first of December.
