CHINESE TRADE INCREASES IN SPIE OF BOYCOTT

Exports from United States for Past Ten Months Double Last Year's Record.

Washington, Nov. 27.—Despite the boycott against American products the exports of the United States with China for the 10 months ending October, 1905, was more than twice as large as the same period in any preceding year.
