Senate Passes Bill Providing for Station Near Cape Flat-tary Lightship.

TWO OTHERS MAY BE ESTABLISHED ALSO

Feeling Is General That Had There Been Life Saving Crew Near Loss of Life in Valencia Disaster Might Have Been Smaller.

Appalled by the Valencia wreck which was accompanied by a large loss of life, persons have felt constrained to write to Captain D. F. Tozier, in charge of the local life-saving office, urging him to take up with Superintendent Kimball of Washington, the head of the service, the advisability of establishing a life-saving station on Puget sound. The necessity for any action by Captain Tozier, however, in interesting congress or government officials in that direction has been obviated by the senate passing a bill providing for the location of a station in close proximity to the Cape Flattery lightship, across the sound from where the Valencia went upon the rocks. It is understood that steps may be taken looking toward the establishment of two other life-saving stations at other points along the American side of the sound.

There is a feeling in maritime and other circles that had there been a life-saving crew on the sound, equipped with a modern boat, the loss of life attendant upon the striking of the Valencia would have been greatly decreased.

Captain Tozier received word yesterday from Superintendent Kimball that he had been empowered to enlarge the boathouse at Cape Disappointment sufficiently to accommodate the new gasoline life-saving boat which was recently received by Keeper C. D. Sturges and has been given a practice run by his eight men. The boat is about 35 feet long, non-sinkable, and the first and only one of its kind to be placed upon the Pacific waters. It is equipped with the finest gasoline engine, to save life-saving men their energies in responding to a call for help, that they may be the better enabled to rescue persons from a vessel in distress.

FINDS CROESUS IN A LODGING HOUSE

Blind unto death, with a malady long since past the curable stage, William Smith, aged 31 years, sent out for a policeman Friday night to have him as a witness when he expressed his desire as to who should receive his property after his demise.

Partolman Goitz went to the man's room and found him hardly able to talk. As soon as he learned that Smith is the owner of real estate worth \$14,900 he immediately advised the landlord to send for a physician and a lawyer. This was done and the policeman left the house.

The sick man has lived in Portland about six years. He came here from Omaha, Nebraska, where he has a half-sister living. She has been informed of his condition. He is at the Red Front lodging-house, 15 1/2 North First street, his condition being such as to make it impracticable to remove him to a hospital. Rooms at the Red Front rent for from 15 to 60 cents a night.
