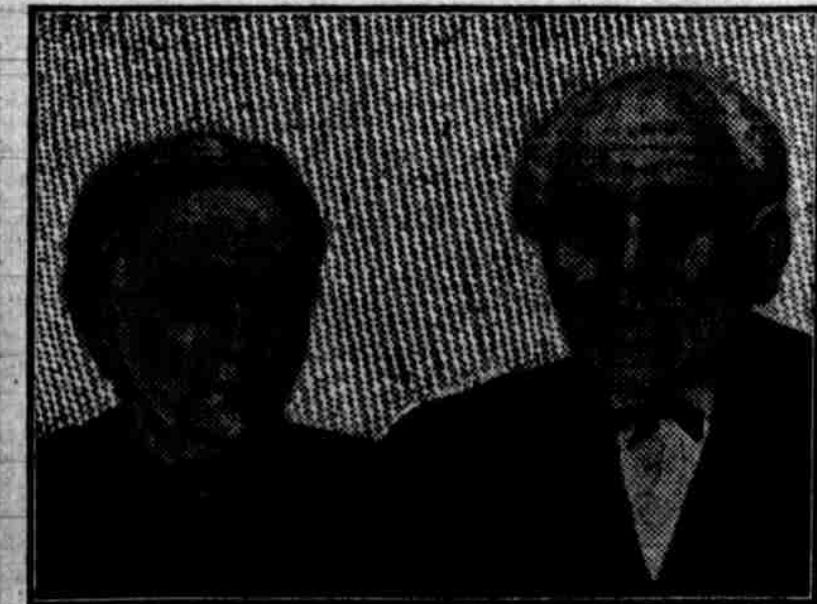
HONORE CHOOSE FIRST DAY OF MONTH TO PROPOSE
