PORTLAND GAINS IN EXPORTS

Official Figures Show Increase in Shipments of Breadstuffs.

VALUABLE CARGOES SHIPPED TO ORIENT

Fortunes in Flour and Wheat Sent North From Port of Portland—New York's Figures Exceed Portland's by Only Small Amount.

From the figures embodied in the report of exports of domestic breadstuffs, etc., issued by the department of commerce and labor and received by the custom-house officials this morning, Portland shows a tremendous increase over last year. For the ten months ending April 30, this year, there were exported from this port 5,855,182 bushels of wheat of the value of \$4,273,090. During the corresponding period in 1905, 1,451,303 bushels, valued at \$1,312,513,

were shipped, showing an increase of over 300 per cent. Flour likewise shows a substantial increase over 1905. Up to the end of April there had been exported 970,568 barrels, valued at \$3,552,101, as against 664,247 barrels of the value of \$2,603,168.

WITHYCOMBE FAILS TO TAKE DECIDED STAND

Republican Nominee for Governor Gives One Brand of Public Ownership Belief to City and Another to Farming Districts

James Withycombe is having trouble with the public ownership question. As the nominee of his party for governor, he was expected to express his views on this important issue without ifs or ands, especially in view of the fact that his opponent, Governor Chamberlain, had made a declaration of faith that left no doubt as to where he stood, but thus far these expectations have not been realized.

Two Brands of Opinions.
Portland has been given one brand of Withycombe's opinion. He went to the state another. Here according to the copies of his speech furnished the Portland press, he opposes the public ownership of public utilities "with but few exceptions."

Public Utilities, I believe, are best administered by private interest rather than by public servants, for in the latter case self-interest, the greatest of incentives, is lacking, and thriftless and unbusinesslike methods will surely sooner or later prevail.

on a way capital. Every now and then throughout his speech he suggested a distrust of the people. The leaning toward corporations was evident. They are not the people themselves, were the best judges of the needs of the commonwealth. Even the reservation by the people of control over public utility franchises had a tinge of it, a tinge that might tangle and knot every time the people attempted to assert their rights.

Opposes Perpetual Franchises.
"I strenuously oppose the granting of any perpetual franchise, and if limited franchises are given at all it ought to be done with strict limitations and for short periods only, and so that absolute control and supervision may be retained by the people themselves, and whatever franchises are granted ought to be taxed at what they are actually worth, so that the beneficiaries may be compelled to contribute a just proportion of the burden of government."

Better than all this is the public ownership and control of public utilities, so that the state and the several municipalities may utilize them, not for profit, but at the lowest rates compatible with the public good.
