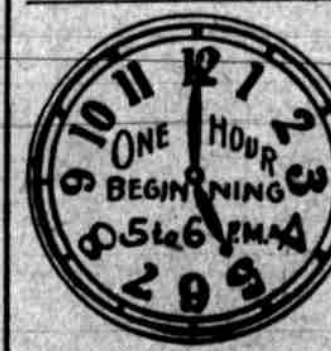

POLICE GUARD ENTRANCE OF MARSHALL FIELD STORE

Merchants Refuse to Obey Building Law and Place Is at Once Ordered Closed.

(Journal Special Service.) Chicago, July 10.—Building Commissioner Hartzen yesterday stationed 11

policemen in front of the Marshall Field retail establishment warning customers not to enter the store. An immense addition is being erected and the commissioner declares the building and fire ordinances are not being observed. The store's representatives protested and an altercation followed in which the agents were ordered from Hartzen's office. An injunction will probably be asked to prevent the commission from carrying out the order issued. After a long conference with the mayor, the police were removed and business resumed. The management refused to state whether it would place the five stairways, over the placing of which the controversy arose.

WASHINGTON RAILWAY COMMISSION DEPARTS

Members of the Washington railway commission who held a conference in Portland, Saturday afternoon with officials of the traffic department of the Harriman lines have departed for their homes. It was decided to promulgate a new distance tariff for eastern Washington. It is said in the rearrangement of freight rates no serious injury to Portland-commerce will result unless the same effects are visited on the sound entities. The contention in eastern Washington is in behalf of Walla Walla as a distributing point for wholesale busi-

ness. With the growth of the interior region and large increase of population new centers of distribution naturally develop, and while the territory of Portland's jobber is lessened the gross business does not decrease, but rather increases, since the small jobbing centers still rely to a great extent on the seaport city. Walla Walla wants a distance tariff that will give its wholesale firms a larger territory. At present the rates permit Walla Walla jobbing at a profit in a radius of little more than 20 miles. Spokane has a jobbing radius of about 100 miles. The Walla Walla men are beseeching the railway commission to readjust rates so that they can compete with the larger cities.
