The California promotion committee has put out the following "Bulletin of Progress": Wonderful activity has been shown in all lines in San Francisco during the month of July and reconstruction work has been pushed with vigor.

Transcontinental railroads report satisfactory business as normal, while west-bound travel is far above normal. The number of people receiving relief in the city has been reduced from 235,000 during the first week, to less than 17,000.
