GRAINED GOODS SOFT

General Upward Trend Expected in Market in Most Lines in Near Future.

SHORT DELIVERIES WILL BE THE BASIS

Generally Believed at This Time That Deliveries of Tomatoes Will Reach Seventy-Five Per Cent—Eastern Buyers Already in the Market.

Principal market features today: Great strength in canned goods. Very dull in beef market. Eggs are firm but unchanged.

Every day the canned goods market shows added strength. The news that the tomato crop in this state is only about seventy-five per cent of the normal crop is being taken into account.

Very dull in hog market. While an excellent market is reported in the Willamette valley from 15 to 18 a pound, there is but little doing at this time.
