The poultry market is still weak and supplies considerably heavier than the demand just at the present time. This is due to a great extent to the fact that many of the larger buyers have stocks on hand and are not buying at this time.

Dressed veal shows a tendency towards weakness although as yet the price holds about the same. Supplies appear to be getting heavier and this being the case a decline in prices can be expected. Hogs are also in good supply.

There is apparently not much doing in the potato market just at the present time and the price holds about steady with supplies of ordinary fully equal to the demand. It will probably be a month before late potatoes are on the market.

For local berries today the very top of the market is \$8.50 a barrel, while one or two sales of off grades are reported as low as \$8. Eastern cramberries, while no better than the local ones are quoted a fraction higher owing to the larger sizes. Reports received by The Journal this morning from eastern cramberry sections say that the crop is even greater than expected a few weeks ago, and that the production this season will very likely prove a record-breaker. The same can be said of Pacific coast production.

Inurovement in Prane Demand.

While packers are not paying over 15 c and 2c base for prunes, the market is showing a tendency to slightly advance. The crop in this state is not up to the expectations of even a week ago. A prominent handler said that on a recent trip through the valley he found the ground of the orohards covered with tons and tons of prunes, which could not possibly be saved. The lack of labor and drying facilities were the only causes. This is the strengthening influence on the prune market. Inquiries from the cast are coming faster, but no large sales are reported on account of the heavy advance purchases at low prices.




