IOWA SHERIFF IDENTIFIES FARR AS FUGITIVE
 People Who Befriended Man and Whom He Betrayed Demand His Punishment.
 Grant's Pass, Or., Oct. 25.—The sheriff of Humboldt county, Iowa, arrived here yesterday to identify S. C. Farr, the man recently arrested here and who

he wanted back in Iowa for forgery and embezzlement. The Iowa official was personally acquainted with Farr, and instantly recognized the man held in custody as Farr the forger. Farr broke down and wept when approached by the Iowa sheriff. He has been a fugitive for the past two years, and so far as known has followed only legitimate pursuits, and has been square in all his dealings. He declares that he has led a honest life since his trouble in Iowa, and would never have gone wrong again. The sheriff stated that Farr would have been allowed his liberty had it not been for his mistreating those who had befriended him. Several years ago Farr had a leg broken, and while he was laid up, and for many months after, he was kept by a family in Humboldt

who had taken a fancy to him. These people would not take a cent from him for board or lodging, and it was upon them that he later passed the forged check, making his escape before the bogus signature was discovered. It has been these people, whom he betrayed, that have persisted in hunting him down, and who are determined to have him tried for his crime. Farr at one time held a responsible position in Humboldt, and had many friends there up till the time of his complaint. Mrs. Cheal makes no mention of his disappearance. It is claimed by C. Cardin, father of Mrs. Cheal, that the suit has been brought to settle his daughter's legal status, for so long as no positive proof can be presented of Cheal's drowning the question still ex-

MRS. MAURICE CHEAL SUES FOR DIVORCE

 Seattle, Wash., Oct. 25.—Mrs. Margaret Anne Cheal filed a suit for divorce from her husband, Maurice Cheal, in the court here yesterday, alleging desertion. Cheal is said to have been drowned in the Willamette river at Portland on June 27, 1904, but in her complaint Mrs. Cheal was in Seattle and was in such delicate health that she was not told of her husband's disappearance for some time.  Dublin, Oct. 25.—In the course of an interview published in the Telegraph, Richard Croker, referring to Tammany hall and its alleged bad reputation, said: "It is a case of giving a dog a bad name, and if anyone connected with the organization, however insignificant his position, does anything dishonorable, Tammany is blamed. "The reformers never did anything for New York. It's great bridges, the elevated railroad, the public buildings and everything else are the work of Tammany. If there is corruption, why does not the district attorney prosecute someone?" "Tammany hall has succeeded entirely on its merits. It is the most democratic institution in the world. If anything is wrong with it, then something is wrong with the people themselves. It stands not only for the poor man, but also for the foreigner newly landed in America. It believes, as against the Republican party, that the foreigner should receive the benefits of the American constitution as soon as possible. It stands all around for equal rights."
