INSPECTOR BRUIN IS KICKED

Thielmann Family Gives Battle to Captain of Detectives and Detective Price.

If multiplicity of charges are any indication of guilt or punishment likely to be meted out by the courts the Thielmann family, consisting of William Thielmann Sr., William Thielmann Jr., Oswald Thielmann and Eberhart Thielmann, are likely to spend the remainder of their days behind the ironing walls of the state penitentiary, as the result of their encounter with Inspector Bruin and Detective John Price yesterday afternoon in the Thielmann saloon at Fourth and Flanders streets.

The story of the case, were it not for the serious nature of the charges involved, is exceedingly ludicrous. In all the memoirs of the indoubtable Nick Carter there is no incident that had more action and hairbreadth escapes.

Grim Battle Begins.

Bruin and the irrepressible John Price started out upon a tour of investigation of the north end resorts late yesterday afternoon. When Thielmann's place was reached the two officers made their way upstairs to the lodging house run in connection with the saloon. In one of the halls they found Oswald Thielmann busily engaged in cleaning cuspidors, and noting that the youth was under age, they informed him that he was not allowed to frequent houses of this character. The boy replied that it was his sire's house, and he would do as he pleased. The youth then repaired to the saloon below and informed his father of the interference. When Bruin and his assistant left the place they found Thielmann senior awaiting them on the sidewalk in a belligerent mood. According to Bruin the father was very angry, but after indulging in some choice expletives he retreated into his place of business.

Bruin followed to call him to account for his conduct, and Thielmann, declaring that he would not engage in conversation with the inspector, started through a door leading into his son's cigar factory. Bruin followed the saloonkeeper. He says that when he reached the doorway, Thielmann kicked him in the groin.

Bruin Makes Arrest.

Although suffering considerable pain from the blow, Bruin did not retreat, but pursued his assailant into the cigar factory and placed him under arrest. At this juncture Eberhart jumped up from the bench where he was rolling perfectos and advanced upon the enemy armed with a wicked-looking tobacco knife.

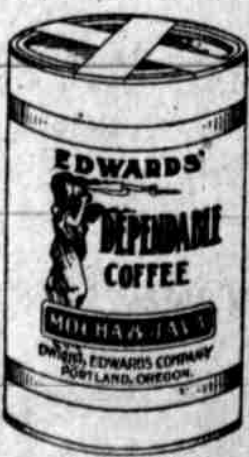

or you're a dead man." The young tobaccoist lost no time in obeying and Bruin, according to his biographer, Price, was saved from being cut into ribbons.

Thielmann Sr. was then taken into custody and a start made for the station. The detectives aver that the three sons resuscitated by Mrs. Thielmann took their prisoner away from them. A riot call to police headquarters brought a patrol wagon load of bluecoats to the scene and further hostilities were averted. Later in the evening all of the women found residing in the place were arrested on misdemeanor charges. All of these cases were continued on motion until December 20 for hearing. The six women arrested in the place entered pleas of guilty and will be sentenced tomorrow.
