**SAYS BAY CITY IS RAPIDLY REBUILDING ITSELF**  
 William McMurray, Railroad Official, Tells of Prosperity Among Ash Heaps.

"The streets of San Francisco have been cleared of rubbish, there appear to be as many people in the place as ever, and the city is rapidly being built up," said William McMurray, general passenger agent of the Harriman lines in the Pacific northwest, today.

Returning from Chicago, Mr. McMurray stopped several days at the city of ash piles and closely observed conditions. He said there was a vast improvement in the appearance of the business district in the three months intervening between his last two visits. Tremendous business activity is the first impression the new arrival receives on entering the city. The street-cars are packed with people from morning till night and men hang to the platforms in the hurry to move from one place to another. The streets once more look clean and orderly. Damage to pavements has been repaired. The Flood building, a new structure only partly wrecked, has been repaired and the Southern Pacific company is moving into it. In the business district many buildings are being rebuilt. Here and there temporary wooden buildings are still being erected on the main streets.

Out on Van Ness avenue there is immense business activity. The retail business of the city is still being carried on there.

"Do you think there are as many people in San Francisco today as there were before the earthquake?" Mr. McMurray was asked.

"Well, I wouldn't say yes to that—but there seems to be many," was his guarded reply. "They who are there are tremendously busy. The business never had such a business. Money seems plentiful. Many people who were poor before the fire are getting rich since. The street-car company has abolished the old turntable at the ferry and substituted a loop. A car passes around the loop every few seconds and there is always a crowd ready to rush aboard."
