TO PUT ALL PALMISTS OUT OF BUSINESS

Proposed Ordinance Will Be Prohibitive, So Miss Corelli's Victory Is Valueless.

After an exciting debate during which the pretty petitioner cast scornful looks upon everyone in the chamber, a license to read palms was granted to Madame Miss Corelli at the meeting of the council yesterday afternoon. Upon the evidence adduced against Madame Corelli in the police court recently, Councilman Bennett moved that the license be revoked. "Has she had a hearing?" inquired Kellner, as he straightened his green necktie. "Has she?" smiled Bennett. "She called me a liar. Why don't you read the Journal?" Professor Burns, attorney for Madame Corelli, made an address that seemed to be aimed at every councilman in the chamber. "You mustn't talk this way," warned Mayor Lane. "Don't say anything about the council. They don't like that." Annand said an ordinance was being

prepared that would place a prohibitive rate upon all palmists, clairvoyants and proprietors of massage parlors. He did not believe Madame Corelli was any worse than the others, and he favored giving her a license until the new ordinance is prepared. The ordinance will be before the council at the next meeting. Upon motion of Annand the license was ordered issued.

BISHOP SCADDING TELLS OF THE EARLY CHURCH

Delivers First of Illustrated Lectures on Ecclesiastic History at St. David's. Bishop Scadding gave the first of his series of stereopticon lectures on church history last night to a large audience in St. David's church, East Twelfth and Belmont. "From the Roman Conquest to the Mission of St. Augustine," embracing a period from B. C. 55 to A. D. 597, was the subject. The lecture will be repeated Friday evening at Trinity church, Nineteenth and Everett streets. The lecture was very interesting in telling the history of these early struggles

of Christianity among the half savage Angles and Saxons that swept over the land destroying and conquering. He showed pictures of Canterbury as it stands today, and many of the old marks where the old saints toiled for the new Christianity in a new country, that are yet to be seen in south England.

SHARKEY MAKES ATTACK ON ANTI-PASS BILL

Councilman Generously Offers Use of Auto to Financially Embarrassed Colleagues.

The anti-pass bill proposed by Councilman Vaughn did not meet with much favor at the meeting of the council yesterday afternoon. Vaughn spoke of it, but Sharkey objected to it on the ground that the anti-pass bill passed by the legislature became a law today. "And many of the men who voted for that bill will have to pay their fare home or walk," he added. "It's too bad that a legislator who gets only \$3 a day should have to pay his fare. The men who voted for the bill ought to be transported south of Salem. If we pass this ordinance the councilmen may have

to walk home tonight. If any are broke I'll take them in my auto. It holds only four, but I'll take them all if I have to stay up till midnight." After the calling of the roll had been begun, on a motion to refer the ordinance to the judiciary committee, Bennett proposed as an amendment "that no person shall solicit any officer of the city of Portland for the purpose of selling any ticket for any entertainment of any kind, or for the purpose of securing any advertising from said officer." The amendment was ruled out of order and the ordinance was referred.

Collect Taxes Rapidly.

(Special Dispatch to The Journal.) Albany, Or., Feb. 21.—Tax collections in Linn county are progressing with much interest. Payments as a rule are in full, and few half payments are received. The large timber concerns and the owners of much valuable timber land within the confines of Linn have responded liberally and paid very promptly. The collections average about \$3,000 per day.
