WEATHER REPORT

Strong winds were displayed in this district yesterday morning for a moderate storm which made its appearance off the Washington coast and then a portion of the chain of mountains to the south of the Columbia River, the main part is still central near Vancouver Island. The following maximum wind velocities have been recorded: North Head, 44 miles northeast, and Tualatin, 40 miles northwest, both in Oregon; have fallen on the Pacific slope as far south as San Francisco. Another disturbance is coming in from over New England, which has moved westward across the Atlantic states. A high pressure area is central over Wisconsin, and fair weather prevails in the extreme west, while moderately heavy rains have occurred in the interior. This high pressure area has made its appearance north of Montana, and snow weather is again reported in the extreme Canadian northwest.

The Indians expect rain in this district tonight and Tuesday.
