

CLEVELAND IS 70 YEARS OLD

Only Living ex-President Hunting in the South on His Seventieth Birthday.

EIGHT OF FIRST TWELVE PRESIDENTS LIVED LONG

Cleveland Was First Elected President Twenty-Two Years Ago—in Robust Health at the Age of Three-Score and Ten.

(Special Special Service.) Princeton, N. J., March 18.—It would require a bushel basket to hold the letters, telegrams and other messages of congratulation received today at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Grover Cleveland on the occasion of the 70th birthday of the ex-president.

It is interesting to note that of the 25 men who have served as president of the United States, eight of the first 13 who filled the office lived to be 70 years of age or older.
