ROYAL ANGEL FOOD Take the whites of nine eggs, beat them firm; mix in one pound of granulated sugar. Put in one tablespoonful of water and one quarter pound of flour with a half teaspoon of pure cream of tartar thoroughly mixed. Then mix all together and pour into angel food pan; first moistening the inside of the pan with cold water. Bake in moderate oven and when baked turn pan upside down and leave until cool. Take out and ice with any sugar coating desired.
