**Corned Beef: Smith's**

Cover with cold water and let it simmer thirty minutes to every pound; or,

If you prefer it cold, take the bone out when done, press the meat in a porcelain bowl, put a weight on it over night and in the morning it is ready to slice.

**Prime Rib Roast Beef: Smith's Price 10c**

Place in baking pan, dredge with pepper, add cupful of water and teaspoonful of salt to the pan. Bake in very hot oven 15 minutes to the pound; basting every ten minutes.

**Round Steak: Smith's**  
Price 10c

Cover over night with vinegar or lemon juice. In the morning you have a most deliciously flavored steak to broil or fry.

**Beef Stew: Smith's**  
Price 5c

Cut in small pieces, brown with butter in a frying pan, then place in a covered saucepan with boiling water and simmer until tender. Season with salt, pepper, parsley and onions. Add dumplings and simmer ten minutes longer, with saucepan tightly closed.

Put in kettle with two quarts of boiling water; add onions and other flavorings. Simmer for two hours. Serve with boiled rice.

**Pot Roast Beef: Smith's**

Brown in fryingpan; place in kettle with a little boiling water; cook slowly 15 minutes to the pound. Season to taste. Serve with gravy.

**Shoulder Roast Veal: Smith's Price 10c**

Remove the bone and fill with a stuffing as for chicken. Tie up and roast 15 minutes to the pound, and you have the most delicious dish a-going.
