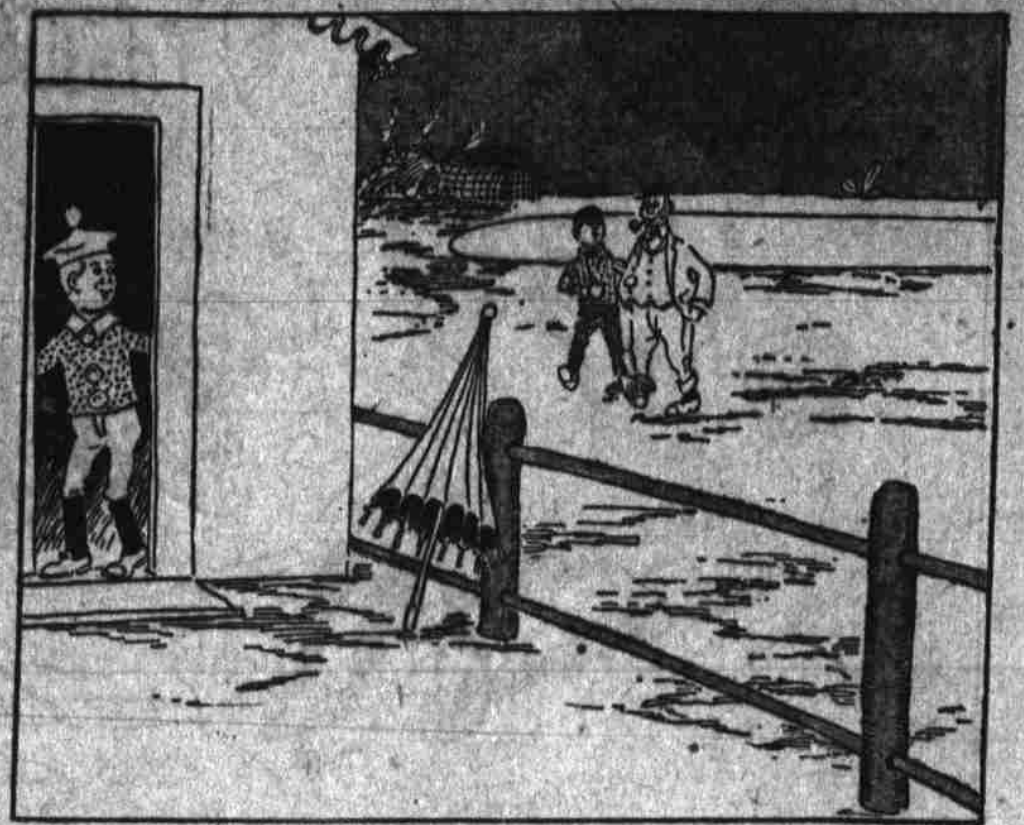
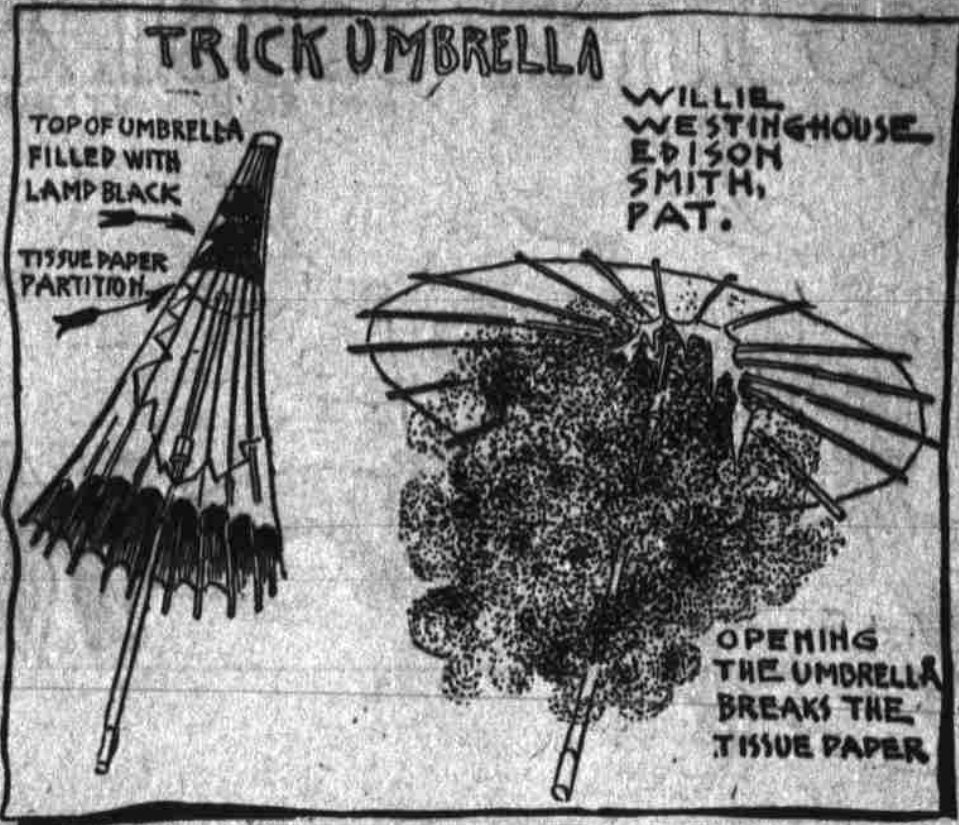
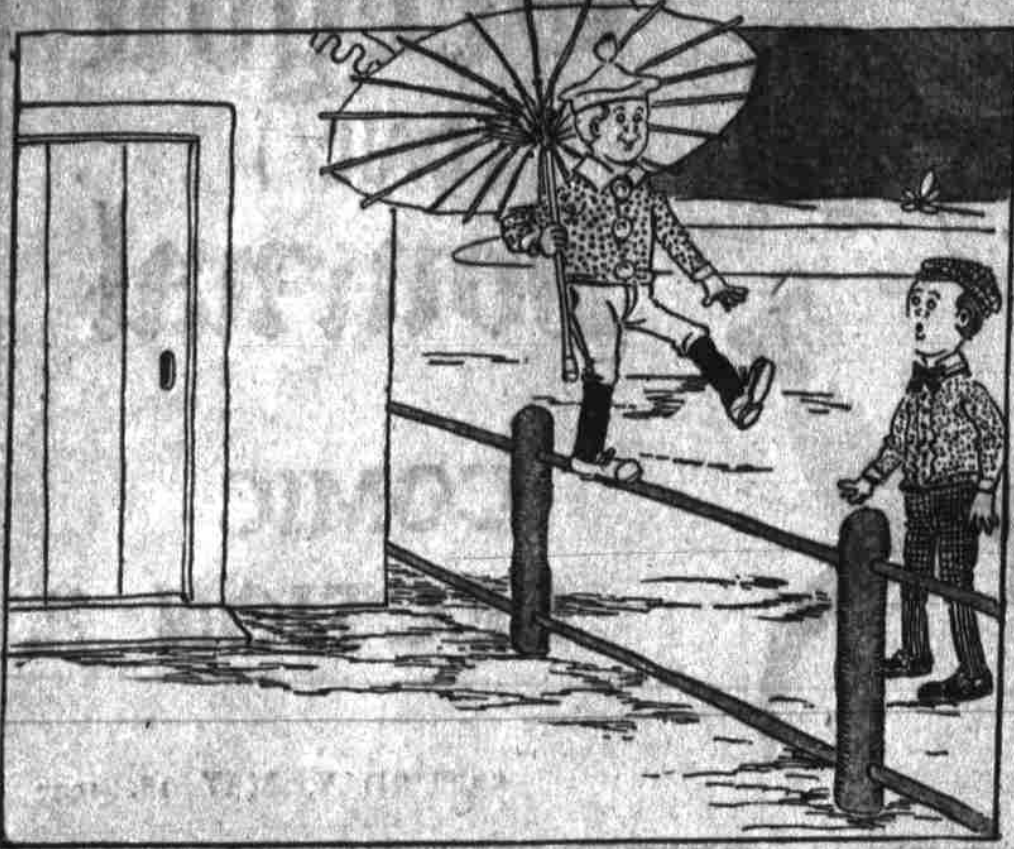


# WILLIE MAKES ANOTHER ATTEMPT TO GET EVEN WITH JOHNNY JONES



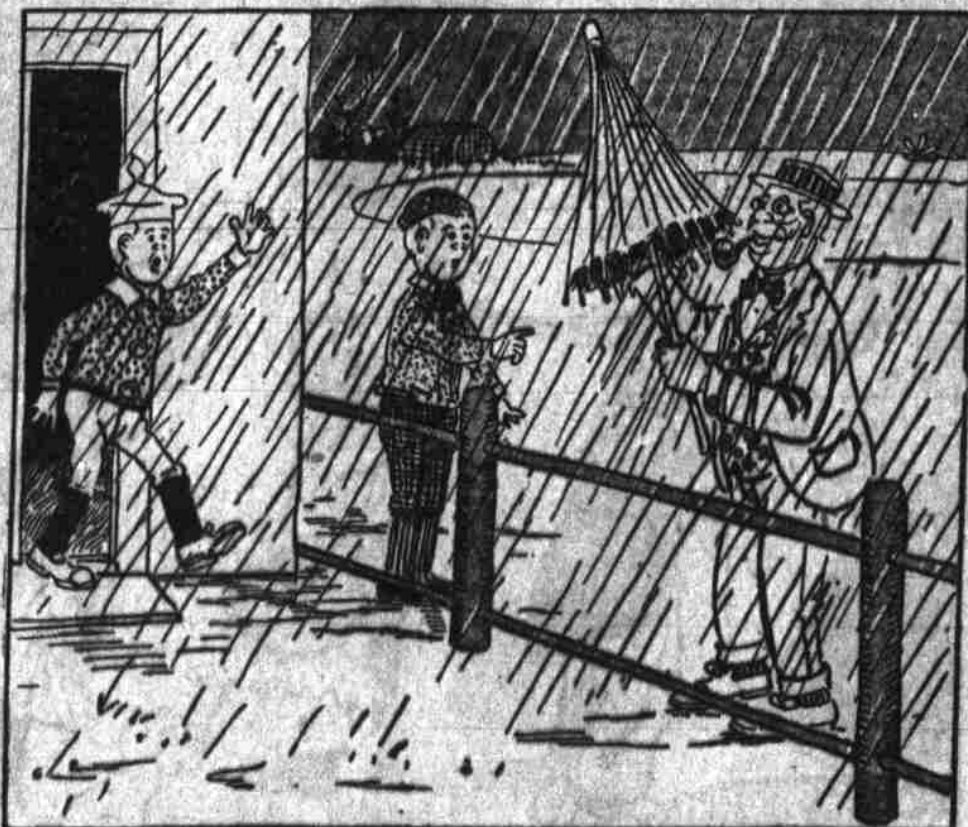
As Tommy—Ever since Johnny Jones cut my kite string I've been trying to get even with him.
